

Charlottetown, Oct. 25, 1875. COUNTY EXHIBITIONS.

The utility of County Exhibitions has been demonstrated. They are now established institutions. They absorb attention while they last, and are talked about when they are over.

But how is a change for the better to be brought about? It is evident that the prizes must be larger. But where's the money to come from? Now, in the first place, it would be well, we think, to reduce the number of prizes; then, in the next place to reduce the number of exhibitors.

If more be desired, let the farmers of each County form themselves into an Association similar to the Fruit Growers' Association of Nova Scotia. Let them hold meetings, discuss matters relating to agriculture, and have annual exhibitions so that they may be able to match the farmers of the other Counties in the general exhibition.

What can the Minister do?—The Minister of the Interior has been nearly a fortnight. But we hear of no banquet in his honor. Congratulations are not, we believe, pouring in upon him.

THE CHARLOTTETOWN-WALLACE ROUTE.—At a meeting recently held in Cumberland, N. S., Mr. Thomas M. Morris, of Wallace Harbor, read some interesting public correspondence and gave some suggestions, showing the great benefits of having a direct communication between Charlottetown, P. E. I., Straits of Northumberland (by swift steamers) to Wallace, and a branch railway thence, via Iron Mines, to Londonderry, Basin of Minas, and also by swift steamers with eastern ports of the United States, and the great commercial advantages that might accrue to the Island, Halifax, Port Wallace, Greenville Village and Londonderry.

A POSITIVE DECLARATION.—Mr. Thomas Annear, of Montague, writes to the Examiner:—"As the judges of grain at the Exhibition held in Georgetown, expressed the opinion that I exhibited wheat of the growth of 1874," and as this opinion, from such a source is likely to be believed, in justice to myself I think it but right to make the following statement publicly: viz, I positively declare, that the wheat exhibited by myself, my son and Robert Campbell, was grown on my farm this present year; that it was a part of 295 stocks grown in the same field on said farm; and further, that 24 stocks (not particularly selected) was threshed for the express purpose of being taken to the exhibition, the said 24 stocks yielded 29 bushels of wheat, the opinion of the judges to the contrary notwithstanding."

SONS OF TEMPERANCE.—The Grand Division of this Order met in Annual Session in this city on Friday last, afternoon and evening. COUNTY EXHIBITIONS. PRINCE COUNTY.

PRINCE COUNTY EXHIBITION day was very fine, the attendance unusually large, and the stock, farm produce, and manufactured articles shown (though few in number) of first rate quality. A lively interest was manifested by the people. Long, over-crowded trains arrived from the east and the west, and hundreds came in carriages, on horseback and on foot. Many leading public men were present. Among those who were Sir Robert Hodgson; Hon. L. C. Owen, T. Heath, Haviland, John Yeo, A. J. McDonald, of the Local Government; Senators Howland and Montgomery; Hon. Joseph Pope, James C. Pope, A. McDonald, D. Hodgson, Esq., Prothonotary; R. R. Hodgson, Esq., Private Secretary to the Lieutenant Governor; W. R. Watson, Esq., High Sheriff of Queen's County; Arch. McNeill, Esq., Secretary for the Queen's County Commissioners; Messrs. Lawson, Kennedy, Bowers, McDonald, and Murray, of the city press.

At twelve o'clock, His Honor the Lieutenant Governor opened the Exhibition. He made a short speech in which he spoke of the beneficial influence of friendly emulation on the principal industries of the province, and of the tendency of Exhibitions to diffuse technical knowledge among the people. Agriculture, he said, as it were, the backbone of the country. When it languishes, every trade and profession languishes with it, we in this Island have only agriculture to depend upon; how important is it, then, that our agricultural interests should be fostered and stimulated. When His Honor called to mind the many scenes he had witnessed in this Island in the course of his long life, he could only wonder at the scene then before him. He never expected to have witnessed such a evidence of prosperity all around; and expressed the hope that it may continue to flourish as it does now. After declaring the Exhibition open, His Honor inspected the various articles collected together in the Drill Shed.

These were excellent. Messrs. C. Ives and Arthur Milligan exhibited gigantic beets, mangold wurtzel, pumpkins, squashes, and generally, a fine assortment of garden vegetables. Beets measuring two feet six inches in length and fifteen inches in circumference, pumpkins weighing a hundred and eight pounds, (as did those of Mr. of Es), and turnips weighing twelve pounds each (as did those of Mr. William Schurman of Beauce) are not to be met with every day.
