Dosco Comptroller Reports Record Steel Output Levels SYDNEY (CP) - An official of the Dominion Steel and Coal Corp. said here today that the expansion of the Sydney steel plant has been restricted in comparison with other Canadian steelmakers but for the last two years the plant has operated at record output levels. Robert More, comptroller for Dosco Steel Ltd., said Dosco has made profits consistently over the years "but these profits have never been very great in terms of the money invested or in comparison with the profits made by other Canadian steel companies." Mr. More, addressing the annual conference of the Union of Nova Scotia Municipalities, said record production has been achieved to a considerable extent by going out and taking export business at low prices in competition with the low wages paid in Japan and Europe. "At times risks have been taken by management when it could have been easy to turn away a low-priced export order and allow men to be laid off," he said. "It would be nice if I could give guarantees of the plant's future, but unfortunately I cannot and I doubt if there is anyone who would. "Dosco stands firmly on its own feet and has to compete in hard financial terms with the other Canadian steel plants and also with plants in overseas countries competing for export markets," he said. N.S. Government Gives Approval To Museum Plan GLACE BAY, N.S. (CP) - The provincial government has approved the Cape Breton miners museum project as part of the federal-provincial centennial grants program, N. Layton Ferguson, Nova Scotia labor minister announced here. He said the project now must be approved by the federal government. Cost of constructing the museum, sponsored by the Cape Breton Miners Foundation here, would be about \$425,000. The foundation would pay one-third of the cost and the federal-provincial grants would cover the remainder. The foundation would also be responsible for maintenance and operation of the building. Mr. Ferguson said the foundation still needs "substantial financial support if it is to fulfill its commitments."
