

Canadian Business Men Visit Japan

VANCOUVER, (CP)—An attitude of "Show us what you have to offer" will prevail when 60 Canadian business men go window-shopping through the principal cities of Japan.

An advance guard of 12 is already in the Orient and the other 48 were to take off to-day—the largest trade delegation to make the trip since the war.

Heading the contingent is Grant W. G. McConachie, president of the Vancouver Board of Trade and head of Canadian Pacific Airlines. Any contracts negotiated by the contingent will come under the new Canadian-Japanese trade treaty under which imported Japanese goods coming here will benefit from lower tariffs.

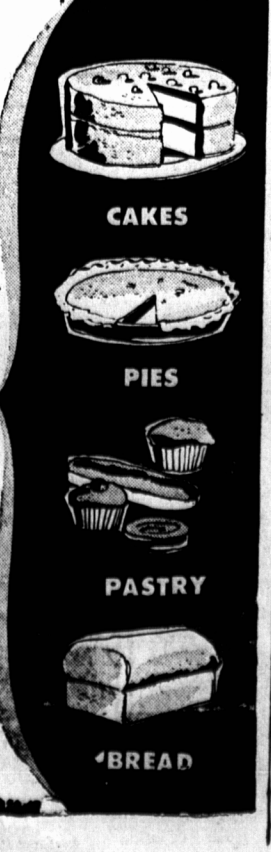

Eisenhower Moves To Boost Defence Of Indo-China

WASHINGTON, (AP) — President Eisenhower has made a new move toward bulwarking Indo-China. He earmarked nearly one-third of next year's outlays \$3,500,000,000 foreign aid budget for the Asian war.

He slashed more than \$1,000,000—58 per cent—from European aid funds in a \$3,497,700,000 overseas program for the year ending in mid-1955. He sent the measure to Congress Tuesday.

The over-all program is the smallest since 1948 and is more than \$1,000,000 less than the \$4,726,000,000 voted by Congress last year.

But it includes \$1,133,000,000 for military and economic aid to Indo-China, the largest single item in a budget that otherwise reflects a marked scale-down in funds for arms.

Foreign operations administrator Harold E. Stassen, outlining the program to the House of Representatives foreign affairs committee said Indo-China is earmarked for \$300,000,000 in arms, \$800,000,000 in military supporting expenditures and the balance for economic help.

Soviet Officers Trail Canadians

SOEST, Germany, (Reuters) — Canadian troops stationed in Germany have become "almost accustomed" to seeing Soviet officers trail them on exercises, officers of the 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade said here Wednesday.

The Soviet officers usually travel in a Czech car with Russian number plates, the officers added. They are members of the Soviet military mission in the British zone of Germany.

German civilians claim to have seen them taking photographs of Canadian troops.

The Russians have been seen several times driving slowly by Canadian camps. Each time they appear British security authorities are notified, the Canadian officers said.

Canadian Sailors Entertain Orphans

OTTAWA (CP) —Canadian sailors on destroyers in the Far East have been spending some of their shore leave looking after orphans. The Crusader recently entertained 70 youngsters from an orphanage on the island of Yang Pyong-Do, the navy said Wednesday, and the Huron, on her last patrol before returning to Canada, left \$11; and packets of food and candy for the 30-odd children of another orphanage.

The Haida has taken up where the Huron left off. The destroyer's chief and petty officers visited the one-room hut housing more than 30 children, donating \$20 and food, candy, nuts, soap and toothpaste.

BURGLAR VANISHES
VANCOUVER, (CP)—Gordon Albert Thompson, 31, lost his appeal against a seven-year burglary sentence Tuesday and police lost him. Thompson slipped a slim hand through the manacle linking him to a fellow-prisoner and fled downstairs and out of the court house. He vanished in downtown crowds and was still at large Wednesday.
