CONTRACT BRIDGE

par. That is, until this hand came along. The bidding took place as represented. It seemed to me that I detected behind Crawford's poker face when he doubled, a note of satisfaction with the developments in the bidding that had taken place. A glance at his hand (East) reveals the cause of his inner elation. Business at last was beginning to pick up.

I was on lead with the West hand and opened a heart, in line with our method of play which called for dummy's first-bid suit to be led against a doubled slam contract.

My lead had a remarkable effect. Dummy's ten of hearts was covered by the king and trumped. Dummy had no entry except, of all cards, the providential eight of spades. A low trump to dummy enabled declarer to discard three losers on the good hearts and make the slam. Our adversaries scored 1810 points, counting the honors.

Had I led a diamond or a club, we would have been plus 250 points instead. Our teammates got to five spades at the other table, down one, for a score of plus 50. The team loss was 1760. We ultimately lost the match to our hitherto unknown opponents by the margin of this one hand. There was no joy in Mudville that night.

I know my opening lead cost our team 2160 points, but it was a bad double by Crawford. He should have had the eight of spades!

The bidding:

3NT Pass 4♦ Pass  
4NT Pass 6♦ Pass  
Pass Dblc.

Opening lead—three of hearts.  
In February, 1953, I played with Johnny Crawford in the Vanderbilt National Knockout Team of Four Championship, our teammates being George Raper, Sam Staysman and Howard Schenken. In the first knockout round we came up against a foursome, none of whose names or faces were known to us (both have been indelibly engraved upon my memory ever since).  
During the first half of the match our opponents, much to our dissatisfaction, played quite well, and as we approached the eighteenth board of the 36-board match, there was not much to choose by way of comparing to

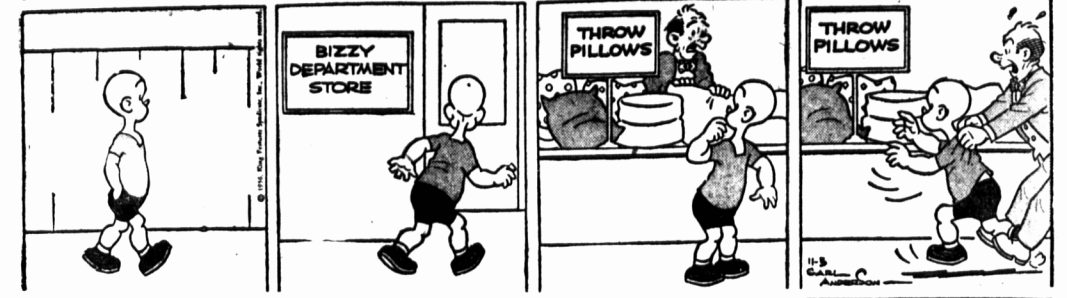
