

Itinerary Announced For Pope's Pilgrimage

VATICAN CITY (AP)—A detailed itinerary of the Holy Land pilgrimage of Pope Paul VI shaped up today as preparations reached the final two days.

The Vatican has released an official hour-by-hour schedule of the Jan. 4-6 journey into Jordan and Israel. Several sources have told of two meetings between the Roman Catholic pontiff and Orthodox Patriarch Athenagoras of Constantinople (Istanbul).

According to various sources and subject to last-minute changes, the pope's unofficial itinerary appeared to be as follows: (all times local and all approximations)

JAN. 4

1 p.m.—Arrives Amman, Jordan, by air from Rome, likely to be welcomed by King Hussein and diplomats.

1:30—Departs by automobile for Damascus Gate, Old Jerusalem, in Jordan, to receive official greeting by town officials; no stops planned on the way to Jericho, Dead Sea, or River Jordan site where Christ was baptized.

2:30—Goes on foot to Praela-

Helga Dan Is Stalled In River Ice

MONTREAL (CP)—The 5,000-ton Danish freighter Helga Dan, on the verge of setting a record for earliest transatlantic ship arrival in a new year, was stopped late Thursday still balked by ice near L'Anse-au-Loup, about 30 miles down the St. Lawrence from the centre of Montreal Harbor.

The ship had turned back about half a mile to make room for three ice-breakers.

The ship's agents said the ice-breakers will begin clearing a path and that the Helga Dan, herself well equipped for combating ice, possibly might reach Montreal today but her arrival could be as late as Monday.

The record for the first arrival is March 12, made by the Helga Dan in 1962 and also by her sister ship, the Thora Dan, last year.

The captain of the first transatlantic arrival in a new year is presented with the traditional gold-headed cane by the harbor board.

The Helga Dan is en route to this port from Antwerp, Hamburg and Liverpool.

Russian Craft To Be Displayed At Toronto Show

TORONTO (CP)—A Russian-built hydrofoil pleasure craft will be exhibited at the Canadian Boat Show here Jan. 31 to Feb. 2 by the Soviet Union.

The boat, about 28 feet long, will retail for about \$10,000, Loyal M. Kelly, the show's general manager, said Thursday. It is believed the first boat exhibited by Russia in North America.

The boat seats six and is powered by a 77-horsepower converted auto engine. Called the "Volga," it has a cruising range of 100 miles, a 21-gallon fuel tank, and can travel at 38 miles an hour.

It will be the lone Russian exhibit in the show. Mr. Kelly said. Two technical experts will accompany the craft to explain its operation. The boat will not be tested while in Toronto.

Manitoba Hydro Becomes Member Of U.S. Group

GRAND FORKS, N.D. (CP)—Manitoba Hydro has become the first Canadian member of a prominent United States utilities group, it was announced Thursday.

Hydro membership in the Mid-continent Area power Planners brings to 22 the number of power companies in the organization.

The American members are spread throughout 10 states close to the Canadian border. Manitoba Hydro's membership was seen as a possible move toward the formation of a cross-border power pool.

MAPP officials said the agreement with Manitoba Hydro permits the exchange of ideas and the co-ordination of electrical planning by power suppliers on both sides of the international boundary.

Authorization and approval by American and Canadian governments would be necessary before any power transmission line construction is begun.

Brown Better

LONDON (Reuters)—George Brown, 49-year-old deputy leader of Britain's opposition Labor party, left hospital here Monday saying he felt "quite well."

Brown, who entered the hospital two weeks ago after an internal hemorrhage, said he intended to have a short vacation and return to politics Jan. 25 with a speaking engagement in western England. He will be back in the House of Commons Jan. 27.

6:30—Returns to Old Jerusalem, Jordan sector, by auto through Mandelbaum Gate.

7—Reaches apostolic delegation, perhaps sees Patriarch Athenagoras; holds audience unless hour is too late, in which case audience postponed until next morning.

JAN. 6

6 a.m.—Leaves for Bethlehem, but departure delayed in seeing Patriarch Athenagoras on return-visit; otherwise tentative plan is to see patriarch in Bethlehem instead.

7—Celebrates mass inside Grotto of the Nativity.

8—Breakfast at Casa Nova in Bethlehem, followed by return to Jerusalem.

9:30-12:30 p.m.—Audiences with yet unnamed individuals.

2 p.m.—Leaves Jerusalem for Amman and return flight to Rome.

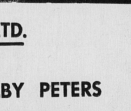

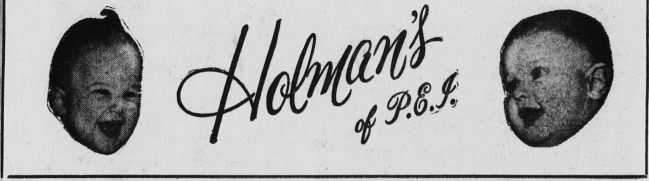
