**MONTREAL**  
MONTREAL (CP)—Prices were mixed in a generally fractional range at the close of quiet trading on the Montreal and Canadian stock exchanges Friday.  
Papers and utilities were down. Consolidated Papers were down 1 1/2 at 38 1/2. Price Brothers dropped a point to 41 and losses of 1/2 were taken by B.C. Telephone at 42 1/2. Gatinneau, trading ex-dividend at 36 1/2, and Jamaica at 26. But 1/2-point gains were seen in Canadian International Paper at 77 and Great Lakes Paper at 40 1/2.  
Banks were also lower. Royal dropped a point to 83.  
Steels, base metals and foods were mixed.  
Beverages were firm. In merchandising, Zellers was up 1 1/2 at 38 while Reitmans dropped one to 41. Carriers saw Canada Steamship Lines up a point at 45. Western oils and producing mines saw Hollinger up a point at 32 1/2 and Home A up 1/2 at 16 1/2.  
Losses slightly outnumbered gains among penny stocks.  
The closing averages showed banks off 0.19 at 63.54, utilities off 0.9 at 148.3, industrials up 0.7 at 315.6, combined up 0.2 at 260.0.

General Motors, second most active, was off 1/2 and American Motors, 1/4 point lower, was the fourth biggest trader.  
Distillers - Seagrams and Granby Mining were ahead in the Canadian section. Losers included Aluminium Ltd., Canadian Pacific, International Nickel and Walker-Gooderham.  
The opening in newly-listed American Israeli Paper Mills was delayed on the American Stock Exchange by a rush of buy orders. The stock closed 1 1/2 higher at 8 1/2. Scurry-Rainbow oil and Brazilian Traction were ahead among Canadians.

TORONTO (CP)—Most of the stock market was slightly off in moderately active trading Friday.  
On index Western oils were off one-quarter while golds and base metals were off a few decimal points.  
The best speculative wins went to several oils. Basco added 10 cents at \$1.00 while Place was up 8 cents at \$1.17.  
Labrador was the one senior base metal to show a plus sign. It added 1/2 at 27. Noranda and Quement each lost 1/2 and Steep Rock was off 1/4 at 12 1/2. Uranium were mixed as Consolidated Denison added 1/4 at 13 1/2 but Gunar slipped 1/4 at 12 1/2.  
Golds were quiet for the third straight session. McIntyre was off 1/4 at 89. Kerr-Addison gave up 1/2 at 20 1/2 while Hollinger eased 1/4 at 31 1/2.  
Western oils appeared cautious as the second part of the Borden Energy Commission report was scheduled to be handed down late in the day. Home B and Hudson's Bay were off 1/4 while Bailey Selburn gave up 20-cents at \$8.00.


