

**WATER RESTORED**

MONTREAL (CP)—A diver has removed ice from the intake pipe of the suburban Ste. Genevieve water-pumping station and restored normal water service to

20,000 residents of the area. At times during the recent cold wave the district was without water for as long as 36 hours and housewives were forced to melt snow for drinking water.

**Ask Long-Term Credit Plan To Aid Exports**

TORONTO (CP)—An institution to finance long-term credit for Canadian exports is recommended to the federal government in a submission from the Canadian Manufacturers' Association.

Under the proposal, a Corporation would be formed by the government, but private participation would be encouraged. Capitalization would be about \$100,000,000.

The submission lists items totalling more than \$200,000,000 which it says are examples of export sales reported lost since mid-1956 due to lack of credit facilities such as provided in the United States by the Export-Import Bank, and in various forms in other countries.

It also cites instances in which Canadian manufacturers' got original orders and were presumably in a position to get follow-up orders, except for the credit handicap. In other cases, Canadian firms had reason to expect orders but ran against the same credit barrier.

The submission—signed by Ian F. McRae, CMA's president, and forwarded to the government several days ago—says Canadian engineering and manufacturing

excel in certain fields in the capital goods industries.

This had been demonstrated in successful bids on projects financed by the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development where credit was not a determining factor and in the "increasingly rare instances" of sales for cash.

**SEASON OPENS**  
SAINT JOHN, N. B. (CP)—Winter shipping at this year-round seaport officially opened Monday night with the arrival of the Canadian Pacific Fleet's flagship Empress of Britain from Liverpool. The 25,000 ton vessel carried 1,350 tons of cargo and 155 passengers on its 43rd crossing.

**Proposed Placentia Bridge Gets Back In The Limelight**

PLACENTIA, Nfld. (CP)—The long-proposed bridge across Placentia Gut was back in the limelight Wednesday. The Placentia bridge committee announced that Powers Construction Company of Miami, Fla., is reviewing its plans for the structure, a bone of contention for years.

The bridge would join Placentia with the towns of Jerseyside and Freshwater and the United States Navy's Argentina base. The ferry that now makes the cross-

ing of a few hundred yards would be eliminated. The bridge has been an issue since Premier Smallwood promised he would build it following the 1949 election campaign. He later found out the project would cost much more than originally estimated and said the money was needed for more vital projects.

In the legislature this year Mr. Smallwood said residents had released him from his promise and settled for a ferry. A petition asking again for a bridge was turned down by the premier and Highways Minister Power, who represents the district, last summer.

**SAID SIGNATURES FAKED**  
Mr. Smallwood said many of the signatures on the petition were fakes. The petition was circulated by the Placentia bridge committee, which maintained the signatures were genuine.

The committee made arrangements with the Powers company to build the bridge without cost to the government and operate it on a toll basis. The company has to meet several government regulations, which include proof of sound financial standing, before a franchise can be obtained. A committee spokesman said it is believed Highways Minister Power has visited company headquarters to discuss costs, when construction can get under way and other factors.

**FEATHER BUNS**  
Combine 3/4 c. water, 3 tbs. granulated sugar, 1 tsp. salt and 1/4 c. shortening; heat, stirring constantly, until sugar and salt are dissolved and shortening melted; cool to lukewarm. Meantime, measure into a large bowl 1/2 c. lukewarm water; crumble and add 1 cake Best Yeast—or stir in 1 tsp. granulated sugar and sprinkle with 1 envelope Best dry Yeast. Let stand 10 minutes, THEN stir well. Add cooled sugar-shortening mixture and stir in 1 well-beaten egg and 1 tsp. lemon juice. Sift together twice 2 c. once-sifted all-purpose flour and 1/4 tsp. ground mace. Stir into yeast mixture; beat until smooth. Work in 1 c. once-sifted all-purpose flour to make a very soft dough. Grease top of dough. Cover; set in warm place, free from draft. Let rise until doubled in bulk. Punch down dough; cut out rounded spoonfuls of dough with a table-spoon; filling each pan about half-full. Grease tops. Cover and let rise until doubled in bulk. Bake in a hot oven, 425°, about 20 minutes. Yield—20 medium-sized buns.
