

SEALED TENDERS for the supply of Clothing for the Militia and Permanent Corps, comprising Tunics, Great Coats, Helmets, Caps, Militia Store "Necessaries," consisting of Boots, Fur Collars, Mitts, Sheets, Saddlery, Horse Blankets, Gun Powder, etc., and other Militia Stores, to be supplied for one year from 1st July, 1893.

The contracts for Clothing are to cover a period of three years from the 1st July, 1893; those for Coal, Wood, Store Supplies and Necessaries are for one year from 1st July, 1893.

Printed forms of tenders containing full particulars, may be obtained from the Department at Ottawa and at the following Militia Stores, viz:—The Officers and Sergeants of Stores at London, Toronto, Kingston, Montreal, Quebec, Halifax, N. S., St. John, N. B., and Winnipeg, Man.

If the tender is not accepted, the cheque will be returned. The Department does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender.

City By-Law.

A By-Law for levying and specifying the rate of Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown, for general civic purposes, under Statute 31 Victoria, Chapter 12.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:—

1st. The rate of assessment on Real Estate for general civic purposes, under said Statute, for the year commencing the first day of January, A. D. 1893, and ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1893, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of ONE PER CENT. on every dollar of the value of Real Estate, as assessed by the Assessors of the said City of Charlottetown, in the General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll of all Real Estate and Personal Property liable to taxation in said City, and of all persons liable to pay Poll Tax therein, made and duly returned by them on the seventh day of April, A. D. 1891.

2nd. The rate of assessment on Personal Property for such general civic purposes, for the year commencing the 1st day of January, A. D. 1893, and ending the 31st day of December, A. D. 1893, is hereby specified and fixed at the rate of ONE PER CENT. on every dollar of the value of the said City in the said General Assessment Book and Valuation Roll, made and duly returned by them as aforesaid.

A By-Law for allowing a rate of Discount on the Assessment on Real Estate and Personal Property in the City of Charlottetown, for general civic purposes, for the current year ending the thirty-first day of December, A. D. 1893.

BE it enacted by the City Council of the City of Charlottetown as follows:—

1st. A discount at the rate of two and a half per cent shall be allowed to all taxpayers who shall, on or before the fifteenth day of July next, A. D. 1893, pay to the City Clerk, at his office, the taxes severally due by them for the current year on Real Estate and Personal Property for Civic purposes.

3rd. Place the telephone so as to cover the ear just as you wished, but cut off all other sounds. Do not press too hard on the ear.

It is possible to talk and be heard when standing back two or three feet from the transmitter, if you speak loud enough, but it is not a pleasant mode of conversation, is entirely unnecessary, and is a serious waste of wind and lungs, besides being very annoying to all within range of your voice.
