Dear Cadre:

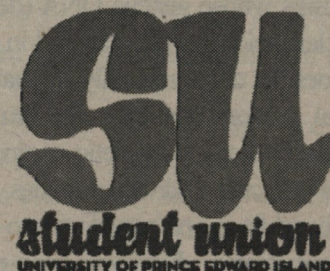
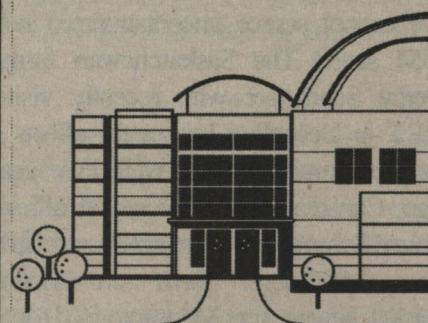
