

Catholic Social Welfare Bureau Opens Drive for Funds This Week

The vitally necessary work of the Catholic Social Welfare Bureau must go forward unhindered. An adoptive home for a fatherless child must be found. The shreds of a broken home must somehow be pieced together for a new start. In the bewildered plight of an unmarried mother a right solution must be found. The ills and the needs of the victims of social injustice must not go unheeded.

Everyone will agree that Child Welfare, Family Welfare, Unmarried Mothers, Nursing Service or Relief from want are problems to be handled with greatest possible care. If it were possible for the Catholic Social Welfare Bureau to provide its helping services without financial assistance, it would not then be necessary to appeal for funds from the Catholic people. But the material things must be provided with money and so again the Bureau must seek financial aid through charitable donations.

While this annual solicitation of funds is directed to the Catholic people, the doors of the Bureau are open to all Creeds for there are no barriers when social ills need sympathetic remedy. The staff of the Bureau comprises two Sisters, one of whom is a trained Social Worker fully experienced in the intricate and varied problems encountered in this work. Also included is a Registered Nurse on a full time basis. Working both from Bureau Headquarters and in the homes throughout the City, they follow their endless task of providing boarding homes for children awaiting adoption, later arranging the formal adoption of these children, seeking solution to family problems and giving medical aid and direct relief to the needy. This broad programme is possible because expense in the operation of the Bureau is rigidly held to minimum. The Staff is supplied practically free by the Charlottetown Hospital and Bureau Headquarters is occupied on a rent-free basis.

There is every reason to expect that the people will respond generously to this urgent appeal for Christian Charity.

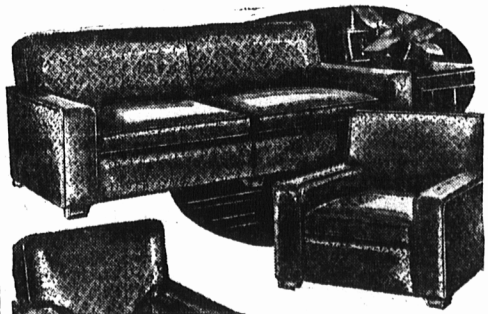

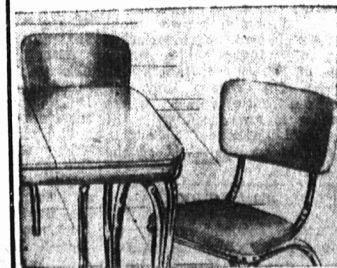
