

### Steel Company Puts Expansion In High Gear

HAMILTON (CP)—The Steel Company of Canada Limited has moved its expansion program into extra-high gear with the announcement by V. W. Scully, president, at the annual meeting that directors had authorized the expenditure of an additional \$100,000,000 on new iron and steel-making facilities. Coupled with the \$104,000,000 authorized to complete this year's projects, the new expansion pushes current expansion expenditures over the \$200,000,000 mark, almost as much as Quebec plans to invest in Sidbec, the province's proposed fully-integrate basic steel industry.

Hilton Works, Stelco's basic steel complex at Hamilton, will account for much of the new program which includes:  
1. Another large blast furnace, bringing the total in operation to five.  
2. A new battery of coke ovens to meet the requirements of increased pig iron production.  
3. Major additions to Stelco's raw materials sources.  
4. Important changes in Stelco's utilities and service facilities.

**ISSUE DEBENTURES**  
Mr. Scully told a meeting of shareholders Stelco is arranging to borrow \$50,000,000 through the issue of sinking fund debentures in the next few days to carry of these and other authorized projects.

Operations are continuing at a high level and sales to the end of March were a first-quarter record, Mr. Scully said.

Profits were affected adversely by rising costs however, and because of the larger number of shares outstanding, net profit per share will be lower than 1965's first quarter.

"We look for an improvement in the second quarter as new facilities are brought into use and more realistic selling prices are reflected in our sales," Mr. Scully said.

### Truman Calls Dr. King, Jr. Troublemaker

NEW YORK (AP)—Former president Harry Truman has described Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. as "a troublemaker." He also called the white-supremacist Ku Klux Klan a "no-good outfit" which should be "legislated out of existence." Truman made the comments when asked by reporters during his customary 20-minute morning walk to evaluate the effectiveness of the recent civil rights demonstrations in the southern U.S.

The former president was reminded that King had been awarded a Nobel Peace Prize. "I didn't give it to him," he replied.

When it was suggested by reporters that his comment about the Negro civil rights leader would stir up controversy, Truman retorted: "What the hell do I care?"

He said he had done "more for the Negroes than any other president."

Truman repeated a statement he made several days ago that he thought last month's civil rights march from Selma to Montgomery, Ala., was silly and had "not accomplished anything."

Leaning heavily on his cane, Truman, who will be 81 on May 8, walked at a slower pace than formerly.

### Man. And B.C. Floral Stamps To Be Issued

OTTAWA (CP)—Five-cent postage stamps bearing the floral emblems and heraldic bearings of Manitoba and British Columbia will be issued April 28, the post office has announced.

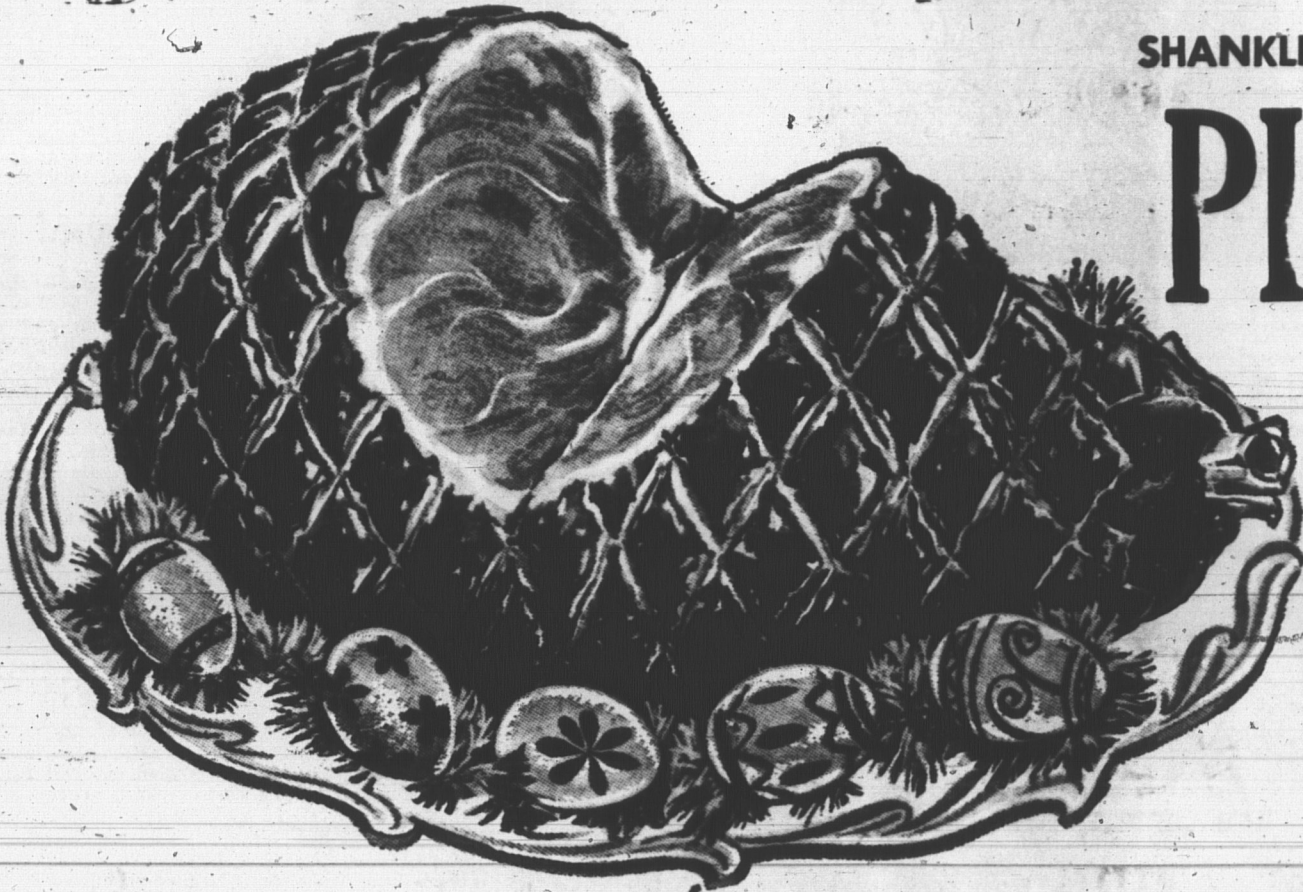
They are the latest in a series of stamps honoring Canada's 1967 centennial and are being issued in the order in which the provinces entered the confederation: Stamps honoring Prince Edward Island, Alberta, Saskatchewan, Yukon and Northwest Territories will be issued later in the year. One for Newfoundland will be issued in 1966.

The Manitoba stamp bears the Prairie crocus, chosen in 1906 as the province's official flower. This stamp is horizontal and printed in green, brown and purple.

The dogwood-chosen British Columbia's official flower in 1956, is on the second stamp which is printed in green, yellow and purple. It also has a horizontal format.
