### Pillsbury Undergraduate Scholarship Program:

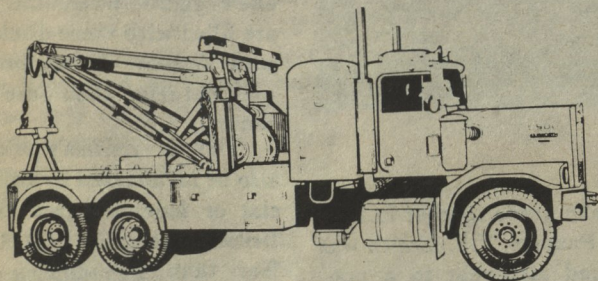
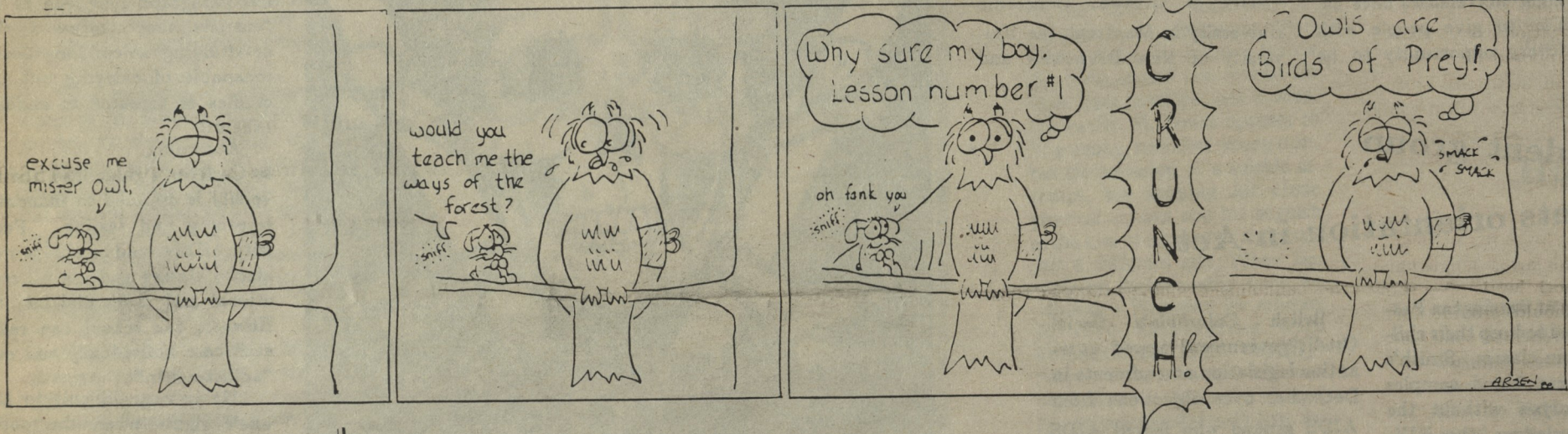
The purpose of the Pillsbury Undergraduate Scholarship Program is to encourage scholastic
