

# MacNeill is victor

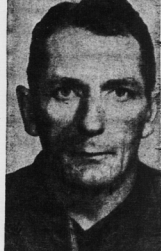
Don MacNeill who has driven many thrilling miles over the majority of Maritime tracks captured the Bob's Toak trophy at Charlottetown Irving Park, 1964. This trophy goes to the driver with the best overall average for the entire season.

Don got home in front 54 times, was second on 36 occasions, had 36 thirds and was fourth 15 times. Don raced in 167 dashes.

In second place was Emmet Bernard who completed in 264 dashes. Emmet sported a showing of 45-46-32-27.

Graham Chappell was third with 22-11-14-17. Graham went behind the starter's gate on 129 occasions.

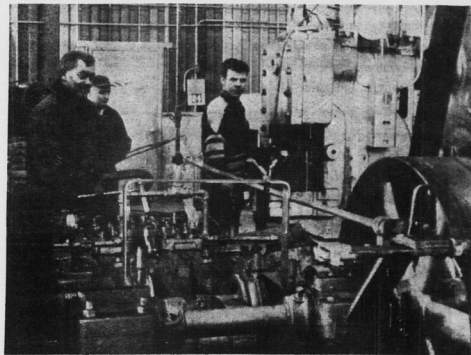
