JOHN BERNARD PAYNTER

Of a quiet home loving disposition he is sadly missed in the home and also in the community where he was known as a kind and obliging neighbour and a highly esteemed for his integrity.

Thirty years ago the deceased was the victim of an attack of polio but recovered to a certain extent and gallantly carried on in spite of disabilities. For some time recently he had been under treatment for a heart condition and death came suddenly at a time when his health appeared to be comparatively good.

The funeral services were held on Monday at New London Anglican Church, following a brief service at the home, the minister, Rev. W. Eric Ingham officiating.

The pall bearers were Messrs Duncan MacLeod, James Gilliespie, Francis Paynter, Claude Graham, Hugh MacRae and Hills Cairns. Beautiful floral offerings attested to the esteem in which he was held. Burial was in the church cemetery.
