

Household Hints.

Cream Candy.—One coffee-cupful of white sugar, four tablespoonfuls of hot water to dissolve it, boil without stirring in a bright tin pan until it will crisp in water, like molasses candy. Just before it is done put in one-quarter teaspoonful of pure cream of tartar and a teaspoonful of essence of lemon, vanilla, or peppermint. When done, pour into a buttered pan, and when cool enough to handle, work like molasses candy until perfectly white; pull in strips of the thickness of your finger and cut in short pieces with the shears. Lay on buttered paper on plates.

How to bottle Fruit.—Take cherries, strawberries, gooseberries, plums, or apricots before they are dead ripe, put into large mouthed olive bottles, and fill very full, then cork tightly, place in a large pan or kettle of cold water with hay between the bottles, and let the water come up to their necks. When the water boils take the kettle from the fire, and let the bottles stand in it until cool. Then mix two-thirds of beeswax with one-third tallow; heat together, and dip the corks into the boiling mass. Keep in a cool cellar.

Cherry Pudding.—Make a crust as for baking-powder biscuit; roll it out till it is about two-thirds of an inch thick. Stew enough cherries so that when they are spread on the crust they will cover it, and be deep enough to make a good layer of fruit, roll the crust up then taking care to keep the cherries from falling off. Wrap a cloth around it; sew it loosely with a coarse thread which is easily pulled out. Allow plenty of room for the crust to rise. Lay this on a plate, and set it in a steamer. Steam it for an hour and a half.
