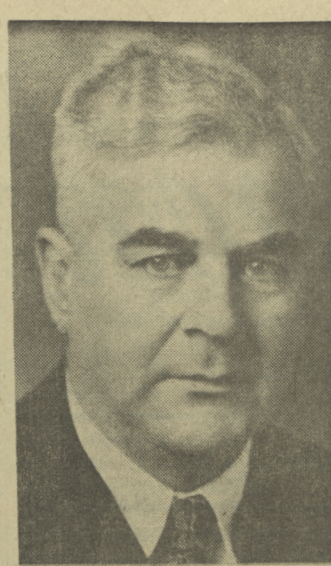
Scout Ass'n Names Dates For Campaign

Charles Bertram Fraser of Montague in his 91st year occurred at the Kings County Hospital on Thursday, December 4th.

The late Mr. Fraser was one of 10 children born to the late Charles Blaikie and Hannah B. (Simmons) Fraser.

In his early life he worked on the home farm which is now well within the town limits of Montague, and helped in clearing it of woodland for cultivation.

The late Mr. Fraser was married in 1895 to the former Evelyn B. Peters of Lower Montague who predeceased him in 1943.

Accompanied by his wife, Mr. Fraser travelled to Boston in 1903 where they resided for 45 years, during which time he was associated with the Waldorf Astoria chain of restaurants.

He is survived by two brothers Elliot and Harry in Inglewood, California.

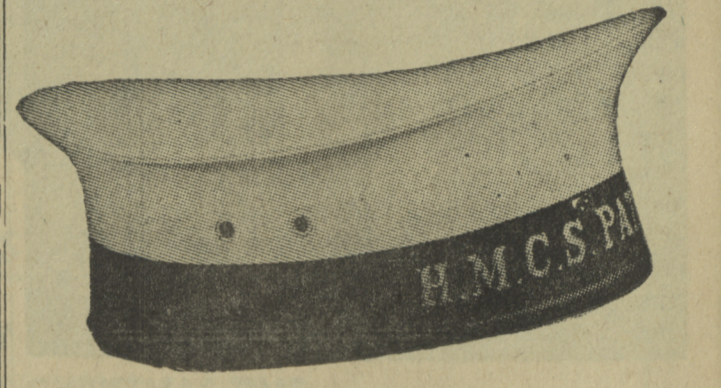
