## Harsh Winters Deplete Upland Game Bird Count

Prince Edward Island's upland game bird population has been depleted by two severe winters in the last eight years, according to J. D. Heyland of the Canadian Wildlife Service. A preliminary report of an upland game bird study carried out by Mr. Heyland, has been received by the province of Nova Scotia. Mr. Heyland said that in 1962-63, probably contributed, directly or indirectly, to the death of a major portion of individuals in the pheasant and Hungarian partridge populations. He goes on to say "the populations of these birds did not have time to recover sufficiently before they were again subjected to very adverse weather during the winter of 1963-64. The severe weather of that winter apparently was responsible for killing most of the remaining individuals in the surviving populations of ring-necked pheasant and Hungarian partridge."
