Funeral Of Ralph Heaney Held Friday At Kensington

KENSINGTON — The funeral of the late Ralph Heaney held on Friday afternoon at the United Church was one of the largest ever seen in Kensington. The Rev. L. M. Murray, who conducted the service, was assisted by Rev. Alexander MacKay and Rev. W. G. C. Elliott. "We Are Going Down The Valley" was sung as a duet by Ernest Dunning and Andrew Johnstone. Pallbearers were Elmer Fyfe, Everett Donald, Reginald Warren, Elton Woodside, James MacKay and Bert MacKay. Burial was in the Floral Hills Memorial Gardens. Mr. Heaney passed away suddenly about midnight Tuesday while driving his car on the highway at Summerfield where he and his wife had been visiting friends. They had started to return home after spending the evening at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Leith Payne when Mr. Heaney was stricken with a heart attack. A bank of snow stopped the car when it gradually went out of control and swerved to the left side of the highway. Walter Crockett, returning to his home was the first to reach the scene and attempted without success to render aid to the stricken man. Dr. R. W. Auld was called and found Mr. Heaney had already passed away. Death was pronounced due to natural causes. The late Mr. Heaney was a well known carpenter of Kensington, formerly of Clinton, and although suffering from arthritis, was active at work until the time of his death. He is survived by his wife the former Anna Brown, his father, Wesley Heaney, and brother William, sister, Ruth, all on the homestead at Clinton, and a sister, Elsie, Mrs. Elton Woodside, Clinton.
