Opening lead — king of diamonds.
Let's say you're declarer at six hearts and West leads a diamond which you win with the ace. On the surface, your losers consist of a spade and either one or two clubs, assuming that the clubs are divided normally. Thus, if you draw trumps at once and then play the A-K and another club, you go down one or two tricks with a normal division of the opponent's clubs. However, this method of play is not altogether hopeless, since there is a distinct possibility that West dealt either the king-
