Worm Diggers Are On Strike

WISCASSET, Me. (AP)—Last week blood worm diggers went on strike in this coastal Maine town. The diggers of sand worms recently followed suit.

Some 300 men who make their living digging blood worms won their strike—for \$2.50 instead of \$2.25 a hundred worms.

Between 75 and 100 sand worm diggers are after the same 25-cent increase. A spokesman, Oscar Cronk, said the men had been offered 10 cents.

There was no immediate comment from the dealers. Both sand worms and blood worms are used as bait by sports fishermen. Sand worms are bigger than the blood worms and, said Cronk, easier to dig. But they aren't as much in demand as the blood worms, which Cronk says are tougher and stay on the hook better.

Dr. H. Schumann Appears In Court

ACCRA, Ghana (Reuters)—Dr. Horst Schumann, wanted in West Germany for alleged mass murder at the Auschwitz death camp during the Second World War, appeared in court here recently on a West German government application for his extradition.

The 60-year-old doctor, believed to have been working as a medical officer in the Volta region of Ghana before his arrest in March, was ordered held in custody until Friday.

The government of former president Kwame Nkrumah turned down West German government applications for an extradition order.

But the new Ghanaian regime agreed to extradite him provided it was given evidence he had committed a criminal offence.

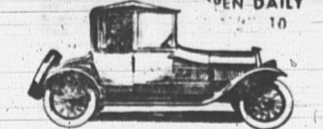

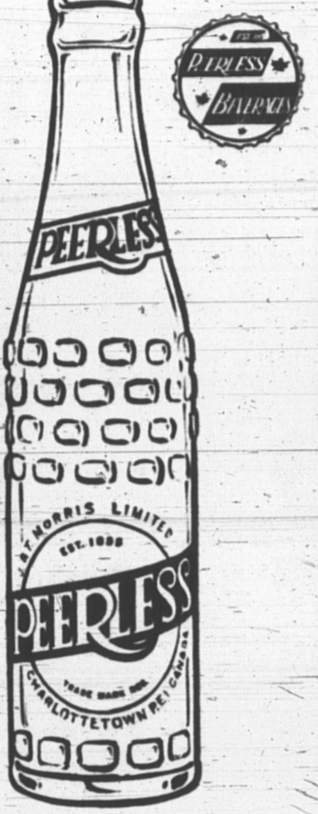


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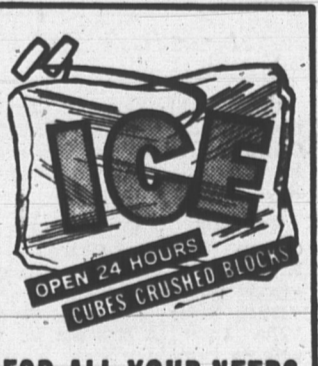
