**Livestock**

MONTREAL, July 19 (CP)—Receipts on the Montreal livestock market today were 13 cattle, 82 calves, 163 hogs and 318 sheep and lambs. Prices for all classes of live stock were unchanged and there were not enough cattle offered to make a market.  
Good veals made \$7.50, with medium good kinds at \$7 and medium light veals were down \$5. Grassers were mostly \$4.  
Good ewes and wethers were \$10 bulk lambs \$9, and culls \$8. Sheep were from \$2.50 to \$4.  
Bacon hogs were \$9.75 fed and watered and \$10 off trucks. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades.  
Sows were from \$5.25 to \$6.25. Hogs sold on rail grade brought \$13.25 to \$13.35 cold weight.  
On the Maritime market prices for rail grade hogs declined 30 cents to \$12 warm weight. Live grade hogs declined 20 cents to \$8. Sows on rail grade declined 55 cts. to \$6.30 and on live grade declined 40 cents to \$4.75.  
Cattle prices were unchanged. Choice steers made \$6.25, good \$5.75, a dum \$5.25, fair \$4.25 and common \$4. Choice heifers made \$6, good \$5.50, medium \$5, fair \$4 and common \$3.75. Top cows brought \$4.50 good \$4, medium \$3.50, fair \$3.25 and canners and cutters from \$2.50 to \$2.75. Boring bulls brought \$3 to \$3.25, butcher bulls \$3.25 to \$4.  
Calves sold from \$2.50 for grassers and from \$3 to \$4.50 for veals. Choice lambs brought \$9.

**NATIONAL FORESTRY PROGRAM**

Under an Agreement between the Federal Department of Labor and the Government of the Province of Prince Edward Island arrangements have been made to initiate a Forestry Program in this province involving the establishing of between 20 and 30 wood and timber lot improvement areas.  
These areas will be properly cleaned and improved under the direction of qualified group leaders operating on instructions of officials representing the National Forestry Service and the Department of Agriculture. A total of about fifty-four (54) young men between the age of 18 and 25 inclusive are required to conduct this service. An excellent training in woodlot improvement will be secured by the enrollees.  
Students making application should be in unemployed circumstances, in good health, possess good character and a fair education. Transportation, tuition, living costs and a reasonable per day allowance will be made. Selections for the work will be made strictly according to the provisions of the Policy by a special Committee appointed for this purpose.

MONTREAL, July 19 (CP)—Quebec No. 1 pasteurized butta picked up 1-8 of a cent on open produce markets here today while eggs ruled steady to a trifle better, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Cheese and butter prices were unchanged creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 22 1-2-23; cents a pound and of-ferings for 22 1-4-1-2. Western butter delivered in Montreal was un-quoted. Quebec No. 1 pasteurized in wholesale jobbing lots made 21 5-8.  
Ontario white and colored cheese were both quoted at 11 3-4 a pound. Quebec white was quoted at 11 and colored at 11 1-8.  
Graded egg shipments in used free cases were offered at 21-23 1-4 cents a dozen for A-large, 22 1-2-23 for A-medium, 17-17 1-2 for B-large, 14-15 for C.  
Potatoes: N. B. and Maine No. 1 mts 75's 1.30-1.35; E. I. No. 1 mts 75's 1.40-1.45; Quebec new crop 75's 1.15-1.25.
