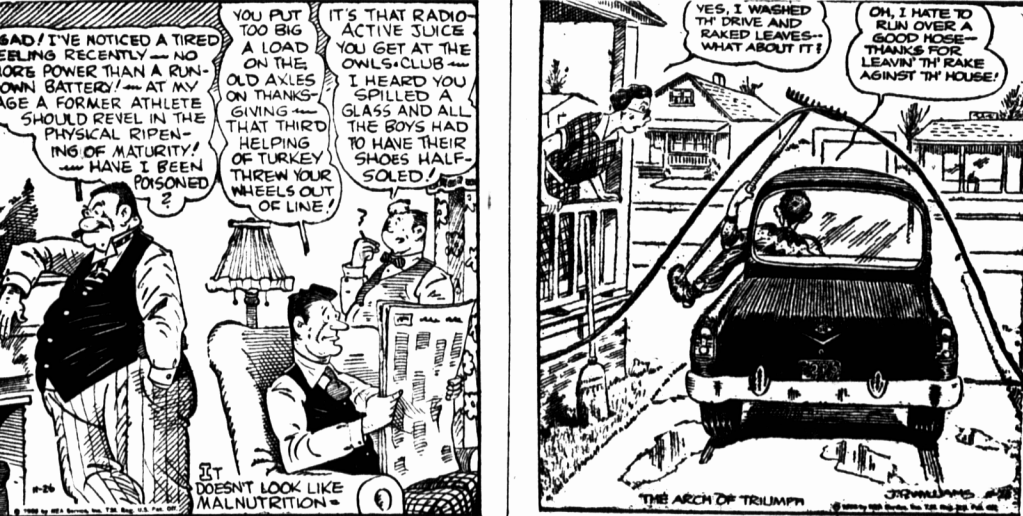

There is a school of bidding that believes the opening three no-trump bid should be a specialized bid showing a long solid suit with practically nothing on the side. The advocates of this method say it has two important advantages. The first is that the three no-trump call acts as a preemptive bid making it difficult for the opponents to get together in their best contract, since they have to start talking things over at a very high level and don't have much bidding space to do so safely. The second advantage claimed is that the three no-trump contract is frequently fulfilled as the result of a wrong opening lead, or, even when the contract fails,

the minus incurred turns out to be a suitable sacrifice against a contract the opponents could make.

A couple of youngsters from California named Bill Hanna and Doug Steen made their Eastern debut in big time competition in 1952 when they played in the Masters Pair event in the National Championships which were held in Cincinnati. With them they brought from the West their pet convention, the preemptive three no-trump bid.

Steen held the North hand and naturally enough opened with three no-trump. Hanna decided to gamble on the whole hand and bid a slam, hoping East might not guess the best lead. East's double persuaded Hanna there would be no such luck.

Dead at six no-trump doubled, East being marked with the A-K of hearts, Hanna shifted to seven clubs, the suit Steen was marked with. The only hope now was that West might not choose the best opening lead. East doubled again, South stood for it, and so also did North, holding better than normal trump support.

West, on lead, opened a spade and Hanna made thirteen tricks without even breathing hard.

When it was pointed out to Hanna that in the East his singleton four spot was not regarded as a biddable suit he was not abashed. "Nothing to it," he said. "Out in California we bid 'em like that all the time."

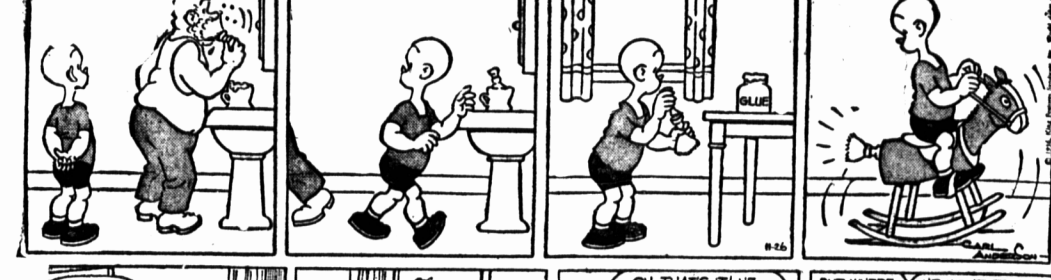

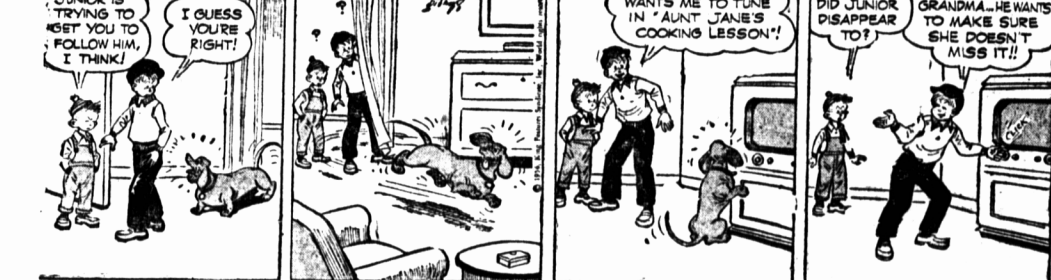
