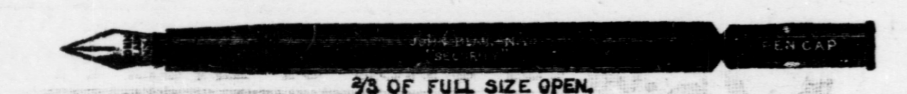

**ARCHBISHOP BEGIN**

Nous reproduisons du "Catholic Record" de London, Ont. l'intéressant article suivant à l'adresse de Mgr. Bégin, archevêque de Québec :

Mgr. Louis Nazaire Bégin, Archbishop of Quebec, who recently had the Sacred Pallium conferred upon him in his gorgeous basilica with so much pomp and grandeur, is one of the humblest and most lovable members of the Canadian Episcopate, although than he there is none more deeply versed in the sacred sciences. He is also the most proficient linguist among the Bishops, speaking all the tongues of the Latin nations and German and English with proficiency. Mgr. Bégin was professor of Dogmatic Theology at Laval for many years, and his lectures and addresses on Holy Scripture are still regarded as admirable. He has written in French several books of great value to religion; that entitled "The Bible as the Rule of Faith" being best known to English readers as it was early turned into our language by the late gifted Mrs. Penny. Rome long since discovered Mgr. Bégin's superior talents and high character, and although he wished to remain in his dear Chicoutimi, the See for which he was consecrated, the late Cardinal and the people of Quebec and Rome herself had long regarded him as the only possible future incumbent of the primate See of Canada.

Owing to his professorial work at Laval Mgr. Bégin has pupils and strong friends all throughout Canada and the United States. He has visited the greater part of the Dominion too, and is in touch with the public as well as the religious life of the country. Wherever he goes he is idolized. Last summer he spent a month to recuperate his shattered health in Prince Edward Island, and not only the Catholic community of the border Province but even the stand off, staid Protestant element were irresistibly attracted by his charming personality. The Bishop and priests of Charlottetown presented him this beautiful address, now for the first time made public, and which shows the tender ties binding Quebec with the Maritime churches.

The enemies of Catholicity generally get a fling at Quebec and Quebec's Bishops and priests. It is safe to say that even those misguided souls would, if an opportunity offered, be compelled to admire and do homage to such prelates as Mgr. Bégin, Mgr. Bruchesi and the other admirable members of the French-Canadian Episcopate. For this reason we hope to see something of them up here in Ontario. As a Prince Edward Island protestant remarked about Mgr. Bégin: "It really does incalculable good to meet and speak to the leaders of a great Church whether we kneel at the same altar with them or not."

Mgr. Bégin is now fifty-nine years of age, but is as erect and sprightly as a man of thirty. He is tall in stature, with coal-black hair and a piercing black eye not unlike Leo XIII's. He is a most fluent and logical speaker, a powerful writer and an organizer of admitted skill and originality. Mgr. Bégin has many years of usefulness before him, we hope, and when he lays down the pastoral crook we feel sure that a broader public opinion than that of to-day will thank Heaven sincerely for such men as he. 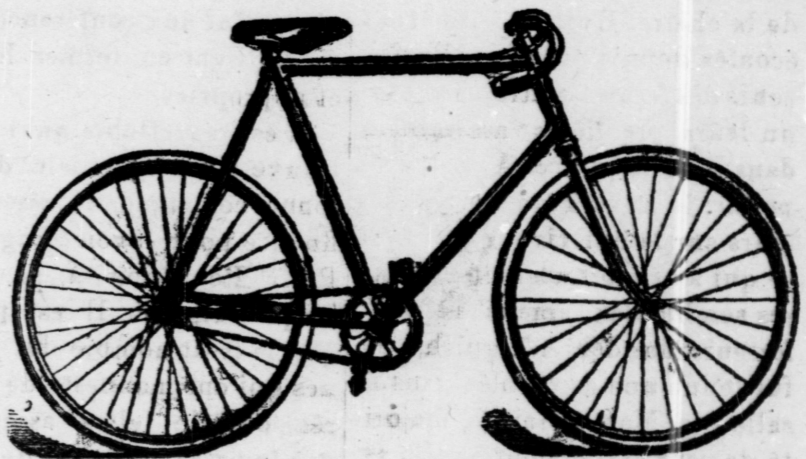
