UNDER TWO ADMINISTRATIONS.

The Conservatives came into power in September, 1878, and remained in power until 1896, a period of eighteen years. The total expenditure during their last five years of office was as follows:

Table showing expenditures for the years 1892, 1893, 1894, 1895, and 1896.

The annual average during the last five years of Conservative rule was \$42,141,763.

The Laurier Administration came into power in June, 1896, and the first fiscal year for which they can be held responsible is that ending with June 30, 1897. The total expenditures for their first three years were as follows:

The exact details of the expenditure for the year 1900 are not yet to hand, but Mr. Fielding's estimates amounted to \$53,050,000. It is likely that the elections will be held within a few months, and the Liberals will probably not have control of the expenditures afterward, but as it is possible the elections may be postponed for another year, it is interesting to note that Mr. Fielding's estimates for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1901 amount to over \$56,000,000.

What great undertakings can the Liberals point to as an excuse for this extraordinary increase in expenditure? They have continued the work on the canals at about the same rate as the Conservatives were pushing it, but what other great thing have they taken in hand? They have not given us a fast Atlantic service, they have not secured for us a Pacific Cable and they can point to no great public achievement of national importance. They pretend that they have spent large amounts of money in curing for us a Pacific Cable, and they improved the great national harbour of Montreal, and are taking great credit for this in parts of the country where the facts are not known. This claim is an absolutely fraudulent one, for the whole cost of Montreal's harbour improvement up to the present time has been borne by the Montreal Harbor Commission, and the only thing the Government has done in connection with the Harbor has been to delay the Commissioners in carrying out the work and to force them to adopt plans of which they did not approve. It is true several hundred thousand dollars have been appropriated by the Government for harbour works below the city of Montreal, but the money has not yet been expended.

But everyone remembers the great undertakings that were carried out during the eighteen years of Conservative administration. The Canadian Pacific Railway was constructed from ocean to ocean; millions of dollars were expended in extending the International Railway system in the Maritime Provinces; the Great North

West was surveyed and opened for settlement; the Welland canal was enlarged; the great Sault canal was constructed; a great part of the work of enlarging the St. Lawrence canal system was done; millions of dollars were expended in widening and deepening the St. Lawrence river channel between Quebec and Montreal, thus enabling large ocean vessels to come up to the national port, and cheapening ocean transportation for exporters of farm products, while many other important public works were completed. After the completion of the Canadian Pacific Railway, the annual expenditure was kept almost stationary by the Conservatives.

The Liberals promised while in opposition, to cut down the annual expenditure by three or four million dollars. Instead of doing so they increased the expenditure more in four years than the Conservatives did in eighteen years.

If the people express approval of such extravagance by returning the Liberals to power in the coming elections to what amount will they run up expenditures during their next five years of office?—Montreal Star.
