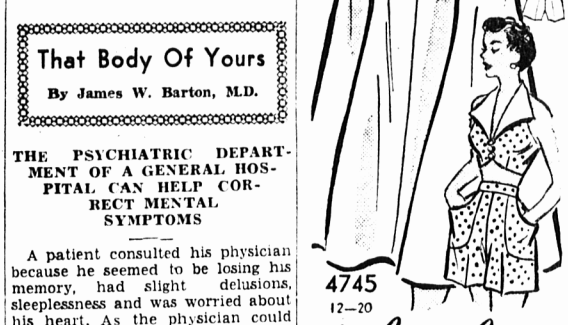

Over one-half of these 300 cases represented involuntarily (unaware) reactions. Quoting from the manual of the American Psychiatric Association, we learn that involuntarily psychiatric reactor "tends to have a prolonged course and may be manifested by worry, incurable sleeplessness, delirious ideas, anxiety, agitation and concerns about the body or body."
