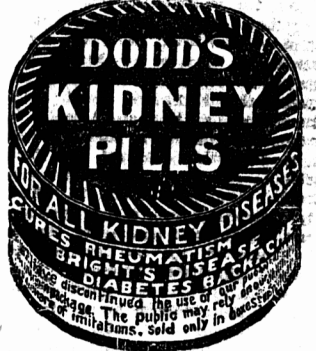

ISSUE HANGS IN THE BALANCE

ST. PETERSBURG, May 18.—The issue of the first encounter between the monarch and the representatives of the people hangs in the balance.

The Associated Press is informed to-night that the Imperial reply, which will be delivered through the medium of a speech by Premier Goremykin, probably at the first session of the House after President Mourontzoff has been received at Peterhof, will, as already predicted, be temperate and deliberate, seeking to avoid occasion of rupture, but on the other hand, not concealing the Emperor's view that Parliament in many respects has attempted to infringe the Imperial prerogative.
