

New cooperators are always most welcome, but must practise a responsible code of conduct at all nest sites. Only a very few well timed visits to a nest are necessary to record basic data and to determine nesting success. Instructions on nest finding, timing visits to the nest, code of conduct at the nest site and on completing the nest record cards are available by writing to the Coordinator, Maritimes Nest Records Scheme, c/o Canadian Wildlife Service, P.O. Box 1590, Sackville, New Brunswick, E0A 3C0.
