Some hoisting levers, some the wheels prepare, And fasten to the horse's feet; the rest With cables haul along the unwieldy boat.

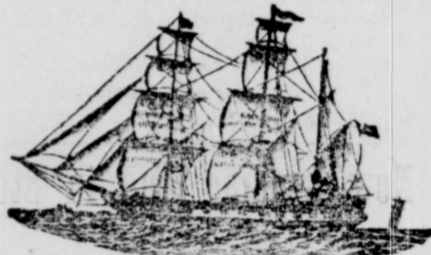
DIED.

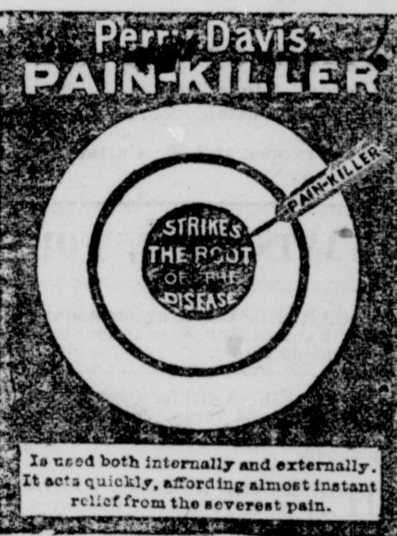

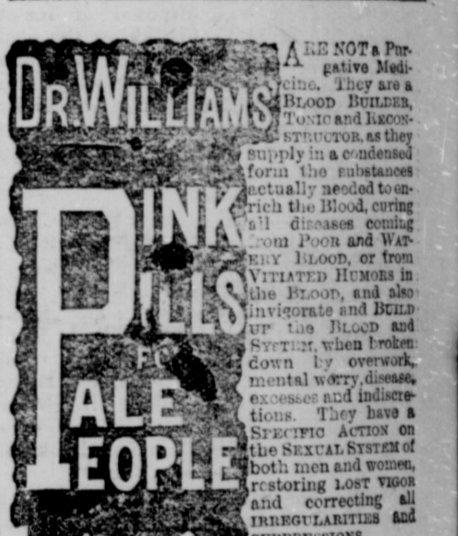
