Entirely new look graces autumn's bathrobe styles

Never before in fashion has there been such a luxury of imaginative garments in which you can lounge at your leisure, wrapped in glamour.

Would you like a "ponyskin" coat, low back belted, stand-up collar?

Would you like a "mink" trenchcoat, complete with straps and buckles and that

Or would you like a raglan sleeved, full-length, double-breasted Sportive robe, greatly picturesque in vivid fleecy wool? Or a huge plaid poncho deeply fringed for drama?

All of these, and infinitely many more in many other moods, will be among the choices of robes that you'll find this fall.

Newly used are the traditional robe fabrics — brand new are tweeds and fuzzy wools, printed furs on pile fabrics with rich depth, fluffy, often in new shapes, printed cotton velours and velvets, brushed angoras, and strong and vibrant colors, and the lavish use of lace, lace.

LAZE IN LACE

Certainly one of the most luxurious ways to laze is lace! It makes a very elegant and romantic robe, satin-lined, a great pool of shape and flattery from throat to toes — It makes charming "little-girl" smocks, shirred and flowingly sleeved — it makes some of the most beautiful of all the robes for the lady who likes to look lovely.

Frankly for gaily are the Sportive looking cover-ups for your relaxed moods.

A knee-length plaid wool poncho covers its own turtle-necked long-legged knit pajamas — another is bias-cut, front-belted, hooded and front buttoned over neat leather chukkas with shearing (wool-on-leather) linings.

The leather boot, hitting anywhere from just above the ankle to mid-knee, is an ideal buffer against the wind, snow and rain that youngsters are constantly exposed to during the winter months.

IMPROVED GROOMING

The well-groomed woman is meticulous about her personal cleanliness, hair care, and make-up. But too often hands — though they are always on view — get nothing but a hasty weekly manicure. Not all hands are beautifully shaped — but all can be flawlessly groomed.

Medically supervised research show that fingernail defects are common in healthy persons and may be cleared up by a daily use of unflavored gelatine — the same kind you find on your supermarket shelf.

You can take your fingernail treatment in a variety of pleasant ways. The unflavored gelatine goes into fruit juice, milk, or bouillon. Many women take theirs with the morning juice. Simply pour in the unflavored gelatine, stir briskly, and drink at once.

The treatment should continue from 60 to 90 days, the amount of time required for the growth of new nails. Taken daily for this length of time, unflavored gelatine improves cracked, brittle, or cuppled nails in seven out of ten cases.

Simple designs feature shoes

The untanned first-grader and the sophisticated Junior high schooler will have at least one thing in common this fall. Both will be wearing handsome footwear featuring smart leather textures and simple trim lines.

That's the forecast based on the recent fall fashion preview in New York of leather shoe styles for boys and girls at \$10 to \$15. Fashion Service of Leather Industries.

On display was a varied collection of children's leather boots, demi-boots, moccasins, oxfords and party shoes, including in the wide range of leather textures shown were smooth waxy suede, grained, patent and lustre, as well as the A-B-C's of leather — antiqued, braided, and crushed. All types of shoes were set on flexible leather soles that provide support and protection to growing feet.

TREND TO SIMPLICITY

The trend to simplicity of line in adult footwear is reflected this fall in children's shoes. Leather boots and almost-boots for little girls are either free of ornamentation, or sport a simple buckle or turned-down cuff. Interest centres on the leather itself — in glossy smooth leather in bright hue, richly colored grained leather, waxy leather tannages in deep country brown tones, or sturdy brushed leather in shades of autumn.

Another school and play favorite shown was the classic hand-waxed leather moccasin. In versions for both girls and boys, it will step lightly through classroom and playground in the popular glove leather finish and the new brassy waxed leather.

The leather oxford underscores surface interest by using two tones or two textures of leather. A second leather or color is introduced as applique, overlay or underlay — or as a saddle, a pupil's pet, the saddle oxford.

When it's time for soda pop, presents and pin-the-tail on the donkey, pretty partyoxers will be right on the style target. In shell ramps of sparkling patent or smooth leather, gleaming lustre leather or shabby suede. Sometimes ornamented with straps, bows or simple cutouts on the vamps, these charming leather skimmers in black or in red, bronze, pastels and many other carnival colors will rival the party balloons in gaily.

FOLLOW DAD

Many a young lad will follow his dad's fashion lead into leather or brogues this fall. The new leather brogues and "brogue-type" oxfords, satisfyingly masculine in appearance, boast light weight leather uppers and mod-lunweight leather soles rugged enough to withstand whatever punishment wood, earth, concrete and Junior himself may inflict.

Boys will be bringing the ele-

ments and elementary schoolers in sturdy leather boots. Suitable for wear both indoors and out are boys' high-cut leather boots with smooth leather linings, or neat leather chukkas with shearing (wool-on-leather) linings.
