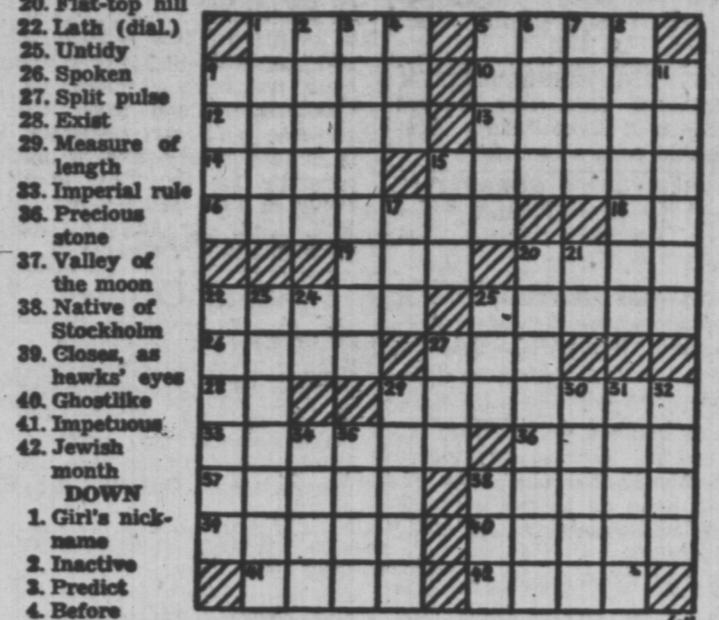
There are very few hands where declarer scores only his ready-made tricks. In most deals he makes not only the number of tricks he can win immediately if he wishes, but also others that he is able to obtain as play progresses.

These additional tricks he procures in various ways. They may come as the result of establishing a long suit, or simply by forcing out high cards the opponents have. He may also obtain extra tricks by ruffing cards in dummy's or his own hand, thus gaining the maximum number of trump tricks, or by any other means available.

Service Wants Firing Rights

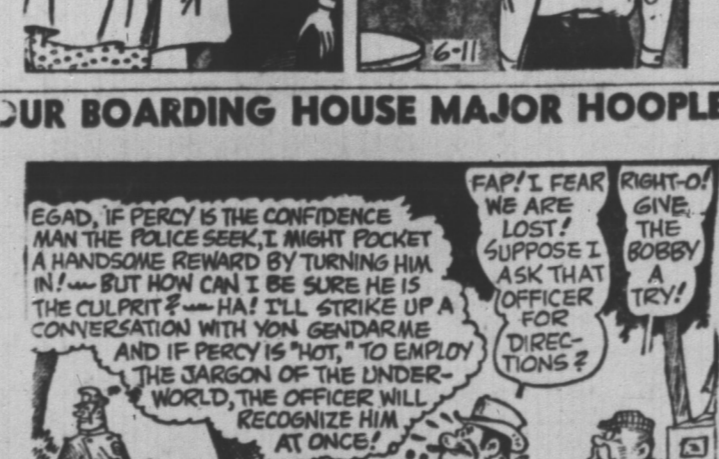
OTTAWA (CP) — The civil service commission, which hires civil servants, would like to have some say in firing them.

Commissioner Paul Pelletier Tuesday told the Commons estimates committee the commission has recommended that it be responsible for dismissing civil servants and that a person faced with dismissal from a department should have a right to appeal to the commission.

At present, dismissal is in the hands of departments and the governor-in-council.

He said the commission's responsibility for dismissal could mean that a civil servant would be moved to another department.

Another recommendation would ask the minister of justice to appoint a commission of inquiry to
