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GRAIN

WINNIPEG, May 17 — (CP) — Prices were irregular today on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange, with Hax dropping sharply lower to maximum losses of 15 cents. Oats was lower throughout, while barley rallied to close higher. Rye moved higher.
Oats and barley saw dull trading, with commercial demand appearing in both grains. Offerings were increased. Barley rallied in late trade to erase early losses. Rye attracted small buying by American interests, while offerings were light. Flax moved lower under heavy hedging sales which found support thin.

During the session, October contracts for Hax and flax hit new seasonal lows.
Export loadings included 230,000 bushels of Canadian wheat to the United Kingdom; 370,000 to Japan; and 145,000 to Belgium.
