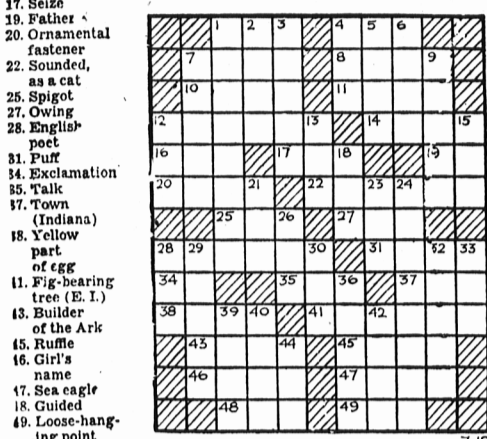
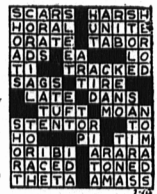

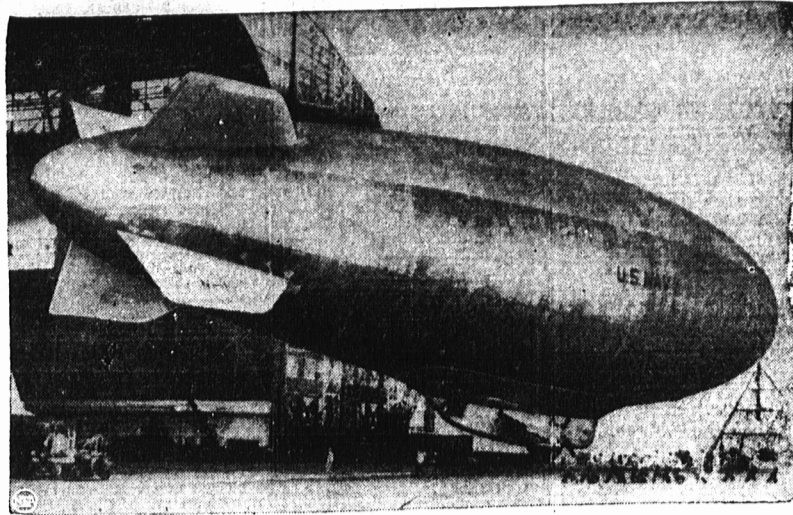
"Severe concussion. He's had a very nasty crack on the back of the head." "I think he fell on the corner of the bathroom here," said Mr. Parkes.
