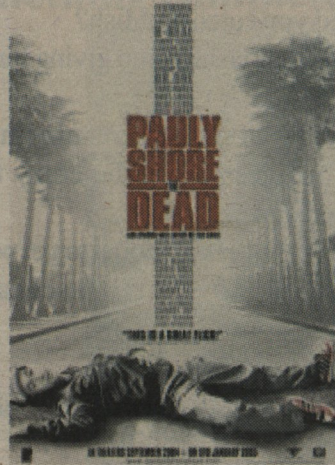

Moncton saw strong play from Kristine Levesque with 50% kill rate. UdeM is hosting the AU's the weekend of February 18-20th.

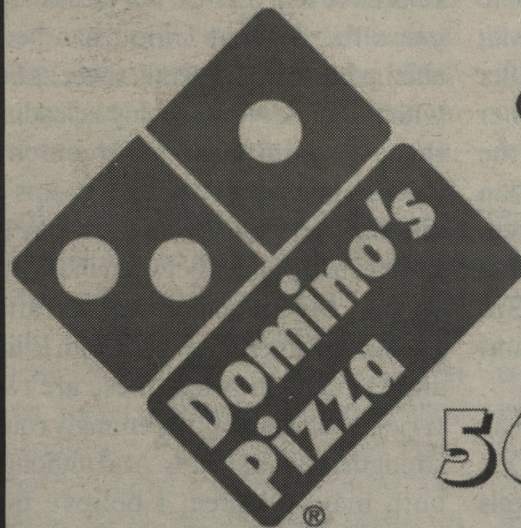
