Canadian Bank Joins In New Financial Firm

TORONTO (CP)—Four Commonwealth banks, including Canada's Toronto-Dominion, have formed a new institution to try to fill a gap now existing in international financing.

The new institution, to be known as the Midland and International Bank Limited, is to start operations with headquarters in London early next year.

Toronto-Dominion will hold a 26 per cent interest in the new bank. The other banks involved are the Midland Bank Limited of Britain, with a 45 per cent interest; the Standard Bank Limited of London, 19 per cent; and the Commercial Bank of Australia Limited, 10 per cent.

The four banks combined have almost 5,000 branches in Canada, Great Britain, Africa, Australia and New Zealand. Their total capital and reserves is \$44,000,000 and their assets exceed \$10,000,000,000.

International Banks will be set up with an authorized share capital of \$20,000,000, with \$10,000,000 to be issued immediately to the four banks.

Announcing the new organization at a press conference Tuesday, Allan T. Lambert, president of Toronto-Dominion, said it will not affect Toronto-Dominion's operations in Canada as an independent chartered bank.

But, he said, Canadian businessmen interested in dealing with the areas covered by the new bank will be able to get more knowledgeable and detailed advice than they have had available up to now.

He told reporters international banks is aimed at providing medium- and long-range financing for exports as well as financing for new or existing projects, especially in the countries in which the member banks operate.

Flour Shipments To Russia Said Beating Schedule

OTTAWA (CP)—Canadian flour shipments to Russia are ahead of schedule, Trade Minister Mitchell Sharp has told the Commons.

He said this is the case despite some difficulties with Vancouver shipments when a 5,000 bags of flour recently suffered condensation damage. That flour now is being reconditioned, he said.

Meat and shipments from both coasts were ahead of schedule. He was replying to a question asked earlier by former agriculture minister Alva Hamilton.

The big Russian wheat purchase involved about 375,000 tons of flour.

FREEDOMITE LOSSES
OTTAWA (CP)—George Demeroff, 24-year-old member of the Sons of Freedom Doukhobor sect, lost his appeal to the Supreme Court of Canada Monday against his conviction for bombing a power pole near Grand Forks, B.C., two years ago. Demeroff was convicted last January and sentenced to four years in prison. The Supreme Court of Canada rejected an appeal heard here two weeks ago.

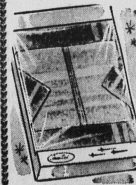
