Canadian Dollar

NEW YORK (CP) - The Canadian dollar was 1-16 of a cent lower at a premium of 3 5-16 per cent in terms of U. S. funds Thursday. Pound sterling down 3-16 of a cent at \$3.78 9-16.

N. Y. Stocks

NEW YORK (AP) - The stock market finished Christmas week with a great showing of strength centred in railroads.
There were many gains of between one and four points and some pushed on ahead still more. Texas Pacific Railway was up 10 points at 170.
Higher with the railroads were the oils, coppers, gold and mining shares, aircrafts, utilities and a long list of low-priced issues.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was ahead 50 cents at \$153.40. The railroad component was up 50 cents at a high of \$122.30. Industrials were up 30 cents, and utilities gained 50 cents.

Canadian stocks were mixed. Canadian Pacific advanced 3/4, Dome Mines gained 1/2 and Distillers Seagram was ahead 1/4. Lower were International Nickel and Hillman Walker, both down.
On the American stock exchange Giant Yellowknife dropped 1/4 and Lake Shore and Royalite Oil each were off 1/4.

Montreal Stocks

MONTREAL (CP) - Prices showed a mixed pattern in quiet trading at the close of the stock market Thursday.
International Paper and Canada Cement each gained two points while General Dynamics improved 1 1/4 at 78. Asbestos increased a point at 75 while Shawinigan was 1/4 stronger at 52 1/4. Quarter-point improvements were shown by CPR at 30 1/4, Abitibi at 28 1/4 and Algoma at 46 1/4.
The miscellaneous and senior metal sections lost ground while papers were stronger. Steels and senior oils edged forward while beverages eased slightly. The remainder of the industrial market was steady.
Mines were dull and featureless. Anglo-Canadian improved 50 cents at \$5.00 in an otherwise featureless western oil section.
The stock exchange's closing averages show banks up 0.03 at 46.75, utilities off 0.5 at 118.5, industrials up 0.4 at 243.5, combined unchanged at 201.8, papers up 0.11 at 128.62 and golds up 0.94 up 4.44 at 68.37.

Toronto Stocks

TORONTO (CP) - The stock market moved sluggishly in a narrow range Thursday and ended up slightly higher on balance.
Golds and western oils gained narrowly but base metals eased. Falconbridge countered the lower trend with a 18 1/4 gain of \$33.50. Gridiron jumped ahead toward the close and touched a yearly high of \$9.65. Merrill touched \$8.85 and Peace River Gas and Bailey Selburne A also ended strong.
Meta waxed strong and active toward the close, turning over almost 500,000 shares on the day for a six-cent gain. New Thorbros touched 35 cents and was up seven cents at the close.
McIntyre dropped \$1.50 in senior golds and Pato lost 30 cents. Lake Shore gained 25.

MONTREAL (CP) - Cattle prices were steady to 50 cents stronger with the exception of steers which were steady to 50 cents lower in moderate trading on Montreal livestock markets this week. Calves were \$1.00 higher while sheep and lambs were unchanged and hogs were \$2 lower.

Receipts: 1,600 cattle, 1,775 calves, 300 sheep and lambs and 2,900 hogs.

A few good steers brought 20.50, medium 16.50-19, common 8-16; medium heifers 12-14, a few 15, common 8-13; good butcher type cows 10.50-11.50, a few 12.50, good dairy type 10-10.50, medium 8.50-10, common 7.50-8.50; canners and cullers 5-7.50; good bulls 11-12, a few 13, common and medium 11.

Good and choice veal calves were 22-23 a few 25, common and medium 14-22; grassers 10-12, a few 13; yearlings 8-10.

Lambs made 18-19 a ewt on a flat basis, some 20-21 for good quality; common 10-16; good sheep 8-11, common 5-8.

Grade A hogs were 27.50, but 25.50. Sows were 18.50.
