

How the Soudan was Lost,

The special correspondent of the London Daily News at Suakim sends an interesting letter regarding the loss of the Soudan. He says: "Not only in the Eastern Soudan, but in Suakim itself, the Egyptian administration has hopelessly broken down, and the presence of a high English official with full powers can alone avert further and more serious disasters. The mismanagement of the Egyptian authorities—particularly of Suliman Pacha, the Governor-General of Eastern Soudan—may be explained on the hypothesis of their sympathy with the rebels. The Eastern Soudan remained undisturbed until last July, when Sheikh Digna, an intimate friend of the Mahdi, whom he had just been visiting in Kordofan, arrived in the hilly country, near Suakim and began to preach a holy war. Sheikh Digna is, among other things, a great slave dealer. He regards "the domestic institution" as part of the law, custom and religion of Islam, and in becoming the Mahdi's lieutenant he has had an eye to self as well as to piety. Not until August 10 did the first intimations of Digna's enterprise reach Suakim. Tewfik Bey immediately marched from Suakim with a small guard and on the following day occupied the important post of Sinkat.

"The next incident in the Eastern Soudan movement was Digna's public announcement that he had the Mahdi's authority to demand the keys of the Egyptian treasures, and even the goods of the Mussulman traders. Sinkat, among other places, received this intimation, but was exceptionally fortunate in possessing a governor of Tewfik Bey's energy, shrewdness and promptitude. A rash through royal man would have refused point blank. Tewfik parleyed, and while the diplomatic make believe was going on he quietly gave orders to have the barracks barricaded and the walls loop-holed. When this was done Tewfik invited Digna to come and take the keys if he could. Digna accepted the challenge. There was a hard fight Tewfik had with him only the sixty blacks he had left from Suakim. The blacks behaved admirably, but some of their Egyptian officers displayed more fight than courage. One of them pressed Tewfik to surrender. Tewfik's answer is worthy of record: 'I have,' he replied, 'but my honor and my daughter to save, I shall take care of the first and my master, the Khedive, will, if I fall, take care of the second.' Tewfik is not of Egyptian race, Digna's Arabs assailed the little fortress and left seventy dead, many of whom lay within the first barricade, which, however, was forced only once."

A document has been received by the City Clerk from the Clerk of the Privy Council, in reference to the petition of the Corporation of Ottawa, asking for compensation for taxes lost on property appropriated by the Government or otherwise acquired and for the revenue lost to the city by exemption of taxation of the civil servants and other minor matters. The document is to the effect that the Government will maintain Dufferin and Sapper's Bridge, part of Wellington street, opposite Parliament buildings, abolish the tolls on Suspension Bridge, the conditions for which will be that the Corporation will make no further claim on Government on the ground of loss of revenue occasioned by the Government acquiring property in the city or by the exemption of taxation of the civil servants.

The Wentworth Falls, in New South Wales, are reported to surpass Niagara in beauty and grandeur. At first, the water leaps a distance of 700 feet, as though falling over the back to the seat of a great arm-chair cut out of the face of the mountain. Falling in sprays, it gathers itself for another run and leap, the second time falling over 800 feet into the great gorge below. The fall is so far and the foliage so dense that the foot that the eye falls to see the gathering place of the clouds of spray glittering in the sunlight 1500 feet below. The valley below the falls spreads out into a great amphitheatre 50 miles across, and hemmed in on every side but one with perpendicular mountain walls.
