## Corporation Profits At Record High

OTTAWA (CP)—Canadian corporation profits rose to record heights in the first three months of 1956 and federal officials said Tuesday there is every indication a record will be maintained throughout the year.

Profits before taxes climbed by 28 per cent to \$728,000,000, a gain of \$138,000,000 over the \$570,000,000 in the first quarter of 1955, the bureau of statistics reported.

Income taxes were estimated to take \$221,000,000 of the total—up from \$260,000,000 last year—leaving record net profits of \$407,000,000, a 97,000,000 gain from \$310,000,000 a year ago.

First-quarter net profits for mining, quarrying and oil wells rose to \$73,000,000 from \$53,000,000 last year. Manufacturing profits increased to \$196,000,000 from \$147,000,000.

## Men On Raft Catching Fish

HALIFAX (CP)—The raft 'Excite' was unable to report a position again Tuesday, but the three Frenchmen who hope to drift to Europe said they were catching "lots of fish."

The raft has not been able to fix a position since last Friday when it was 580 miles east of here. But the adventurers told amateur radio operators Tuesday they were feeling fine and being driven slowly by southwest winds.
