MINING EXCHANGE

TORONTO, May 6—Trading hit a fast pace on the Toronto mining market today sending aggregate volume to 2,998,000 shares, the heaviest turnover since Jan. 24. Volume figures were up mainly on the buying rush in the issues selling around 50 cents to \$2. Hard Rock was again a star performer and it held a gain of 17 cents to 1.79 on a turnover of 128,000 shares. Howey had an even larger trade but profit-taking was in evidence and the price weakened 8 cents to 78. Other out-standing traders were J. M. Consolidated, up 4 cents, Argosy, up 5 cents, God's Lake, up 6 cents, Paymaster up 12 and Ventures up 5 to 1.96. Dome led the big goods with a gain of 2 1-4 cents to 56, followed by Lake Shore's advance of 1 1-4. Hollinger added 1-8, McIntyre 1-4. Pioneer and Wright Hargreaves 20 cents each and Teck Hughes 15 cents each. Little Long Lac added 5 cents and Pickle Crow was unchanged.
