## WELL MANAGED.

The Montreal Witness remarks that by taking possession of the Orange Free State as conquered territory, and without going through any formalities of a surrender by the late government on certain agreed terms, the establishment of British authority will be absolute. The Colonel Office will, therefore, be in a position to adopt such measures as may be required for the peace, order and good government of the Orange River Colony, free from hampering conditions which, in case of a surrender, would have the force of common law forever. The same course will be pursued, no doubt, with reference to the Transvaal and, as the grand object of the British Government, backed by the people of the Empire, is to establish freedom, justice and equal rights for all men, the pacification of the country may be looked for at a reasonably early date. A pastoral people, such as the Boers, living in widely scattered ranches, are not likely to become troublesome again in a hurry after the terrible lesson they have had of the power and resources of Great Britain. They now know who and what they have to deal with something they did not know when they undertook to drive the British power out of South Africa, and they are not likely to forget it.

An Austrian who has had seven months' service in the Transvaal declares, so it is reported, the arrangement whereby the British prisoners at Pretoria were placed under an armed guard with British officers pending the formal occupation of the town is ascribed to the good sense and humane disposition of General Louis Botha and the Transvaal war secretary, both of whom have earned the profound respect of all classes.

In the course of a recent letter to a friend, Mr. F. B. McRae, says finely: "No man can estimate the amount of good this war has done for Britain's national life. What do the pessimists claim that the Queen's vast domain only existed on paper, and that its decline was near at hand, say now? We Canadians rejoice at meeting our cousins on the battlefield from every British land and united with them in a determined effort to uphold our country's prestige. With the beginning of this war the British Empire emerged from the foggy regions of doubt into the bright sunshine of accomplished fact, and with its termination will begin the brightest chapter in her long and glorious history."

## Shattered Diamonds.

"Under certain conditions, which are very rare and remarkable," said an old jeweler, "a diamond may be shattered to atoms by a smart, sudden blow. The stone seems to disintegrate and fly apart, as nearly as I can express it, and when the Kimberley gems first came into the market the Brazilian brokers claimed that they were especially subject to that kind of accident. For the time being the story had its effect on trade, but it was proved to be untrue, and the incident is now forgotten. In the course of an experience of nearly 40 years I have known of only two cases of diamonds being broken."

"One occurred many years ago, when I was working in a shop in the old Reid House in Chattanooga. A lady customer dropped a cluster brooch from the counter to the tiled floor, a distance of about 3½ feet. It struck squarely on the center stone, which was broken into a number of small, irregular fragments. The diamond had weighed about two carats.

"The other instance took place here in New Orleans about six years ago. A St. Louis traveling man named Crawford had a solitaire weighing 1½ carats set in a ring. He was standing in the store and while conversing about something made a sudden gesture and struck the stone against a metal fixture. It was split into small, jagged splinters, a number of which we found on top of the showcase. The drummer himself was the most astonished man I ever saw. He had supposed diamonds were indestructible simply because they were hard."—New Orleans Times-Democrat.
