Students who plan to return to UPEI in September, 1978, are requested to complete an application form at the Registrar's Office before they leave for the summer.

All students who complete the application form will be forwarded material during the summer so that they may register by mail and avoid the line-ups during September registration.

All students who choose their courses and who pay fees by mail will be required only to sign in when they return for classes in September.

All students who choose their courses but who do not pay their fees will be required to pay their fees and sign in when they return in September. Some courses will have limited enrolments so students would be well advised to register by mail to avoid the possibility of not getting into a course which is filled.
