New York Stocks

NEW YORK, (AP)—The stock market ended the week with a pre-holiday showing of strength. The gains surprised those in Wall Street who had looked for a precautionary selloff before the three-day recess over Labor Day. The rise went to between 1 and 2 points while losses were held down to fractions in most cases. Most major divisions improved: Steels, railroads, oils especially, non-ferrous metals, motors, aircrafts, chemicals, utilities and some textiles.

Canadian Dollar

MONTREAL (CP)—The U. S. dollar closed at a discount of 2 1/2 per cent in terms of Canadian funds, down 1-3/2 Friday. It took 97 1/2 cents Canadian to buy \$1 American. Pound sterling \$2.72 7/8, down 1/8.

WINNIPEG (CP)—Rye prices advanced to seasonal highs on the Winnipeg grain exchange Friday. There was no information on overnight export loadings of Canadian wheat but trade reports indicated the sale of five cargoes of wheat to Japan. Lakehead prices of class two, IWA and domestic wheat were down 1/2 cent, except class two durums which were unchanged.

Toronto Stocks

TORONTO, (CP)—The stock market forged ahead with heavy trading Friday. Western oils closed with almost twice as many gains as losses. Senior base metals were ahead in almost a solid line, led by Hudson Bay and Noranda. Junior base metals were narrowly ahead, led by Multi Minerals which hit a 1954 high on reports of a good columbium find. Senior golds closed exceptionally strong with Dome up \$1, McIntyre up \$1.25 in light turnover, and almost all the other big producers ahead fractions. In the stock juniors Campbell Red Lake took the spotlight, climbing more than \$1 to a 1954 high of \$9.30. Manitowadge issues saw Willroy and Consolidated Hovey well ahead. Ascot gained pennies in active dealings following reports it is negotiating for control of a new uranium discovery. Uraniums were the market's only easier section but price drops were small.

MONTREAL, (CP)—Stock market prices leaped forward in dull trading Friday. A mixed tone ruled the papers and utility sections while carriers and steels showed little change. The remainder of the industrial market gained strength. Mines improved with Dome up 1 1/8 points. Pato gained 30 cents and Willroy was 20 cents higher. Western oils were narrowly mixed in featureless trading.
