The following scholarships are being published in this column once again as a reminder to those students who are interested in applying for them, that the deadlines are drawing near.

Canada Mortgage & Housing — Deadline Friday, March 16th
Students applying for these scholarships must be seeking a masters or doctoral degree.

75 Scholarships for '84-85 for full-time study in Canada in various aspects of housing (urban planning, law, engineering, public administration, economics, sociology and architecture).

Scholarships include travel expenses, tuition fees, allowance of \$1,494.00 per dependant and a personal stipend of \$9,348.00.

George & Nora Elwin Scholarships —

Deadline Saturday, March 31st

To study at McMaster University.

McMaster offers up to five prestigious scholarships for outstanding students from all over Canada to study at the university.

Students from P.E.I. must have completed one year of university in Arts, Sciences, Business, Engineering, Nursing or Physical Education.

Value of the scholarship is \$2,500/year.

Address needed to obtain application for the scholarship may be obtained in Student Services financial aid files.

University Women's Club of Saint John, N.B. —

Deadline March 31st.

The University Women's Club of Saint John annually offers a scholarship of \$600 to a female student entering her Senior year of university.

To be eligible a student must have graduated from a high school in Saint John or Kings County, New Brunswick.
