

Canadian Backing Remains For U.S. In Viet Nam War

OTTAWA (CP) — Canadian government support for American principles and objectives in Viet Nam has not been shaken by U.S. rejection of offers or purported offers to negotiate, informed sources said here.

They said Communist North Viet Nam has attached conditions to any negotiations, the chief one being American withdrawal from South Viet Nam before peace talks can begin. The U.S. since April has offered to negotiate unconditionally.

An external affairs department spokesman said there has been no perceptible change in Hanoi's position. If anything, he said, North Viet Nam's attitude has become harder and more inflexible.

North Viet Nam attached great importance to protests in the U.S. against the Viet Nam war. It seemed to be convinced — mistakenly — that it could hold out long enough public opinion in the U.S. and elsewhere would force a unilateral American withdrawal from South Viet Nam.

DECLINES COMMENT
Officials here declined to be drawn into discussion of how the American public was informed — or misinformed — by the U.S. government concerning proposals for negotiations. This was strictly an American domestic affair, they said.

all diplomatic moves in the Viet Nam situation, including the two disclosed last week.

Moreover, as a member of the 11-year-old International Supervisory Commission in Viet Nam, Canada had first-hand knowledge of the North Vietnamese attitude.

J. Blair Seaborn, Canadian delegate on the commission, was sent to Hanoi May 31 by External Affairs Minister Martin to get the reaction of North Viet Nam to the five-day pause earlier that month in U.S. bombings.

Mr. Seaborn's mission occurred soon after — but was not connected with — North Viet Nam's feier made through French diplomats.

Sources said the end result was the same: North Viet Nam attached conditions to any negotiations with the U.S. The Canadian government has

generally supported U.S. policy in Viet Nam because, as Mr. Martin put it in April, if South Viet Nam were left to the mercy of the Communists by an American withdrawal, "then it would be only a matter of time before the next victim is selected."

However, Canada proposed unconditional negotiations, a position later accepted by the U.S. months after Mr. Thant's original initiative.

In April, Prime Minister Pearson suggested a pause in American bombings of North Viet Nam. The U.S. did so the following month.

In March, Canada made public documents placing the major blame for the Viet Nam situation on Communist subversion through infiltration of arms, troops, terrorists and saboteurs from North Viet Nam.

SEXY WAITRESS RULING GIVEN OKAY BY BOARD

SEATTLE (AP) — A cocktail-lounge requirement that waitresses be sexy does not necessarily violate Washington state laws against discrimination because of age, the state board against discrimination has decided.

The board adopted the policy statement in answer to complaints by two waitresses that they were fired because they were too old and not sexy enough.

"Even slight familiarity with cocktail lounges in 1965 demonstrates legitimate business reasons for a management desire that cocktail waitresses be 'sexy,'" the statement said.

The two waitresses, Mrs. Darlene Smith and Mrs. Jean

Strzelecki, are 32 and 36 respectively.

"Sexiness as a job requirement weighs the scale in favor of younger women, and thus comes within the general area of age discrimination," the statement said.

However, it noted that many job requirements, such as professional athletes, favor certain age brackets without being discriminatory.

Noting that certain job specifications may relate to age without being correlated with it, the policy statement said:

"Nor is a requirement of sexiness necessarily correlated with age. Some older women are sexy (Marlene Dietrich comes to mind) and

Elections Act Said Deficient

OTTAWA (CP) — The Canada Elections Act is deficient in not allowing scrutineers in returning offices on election day, the defeated Liberal candidate in Carleton riding said Monday.

Lloyd Francis, who ran second to R. A. Bell, former Conservative immigration minister, said in an interview he has spelled out the deficiency in a letter to Nelson Castonguay, acting chief electoral officer.
