strong signal at 700AM on your radio dial. If you live off campus, our signal will be going out on cable FM in a few weeks, you will be able to receive it by hooking your T.V. cable to the FM antenna output on your radio.

CIMN has become one of the best student radio stations in the country, mainly because the Student Union Executive-- John MacDougall-President... Brian Brennan and Victor Moore-Vice Presidents and Glen Hynes Treasurer decided to hire a professional Radio Engineer-- John Bently and build a new station.

Gordon Johnston a professional programmer and music director started from scratch and built a completely new library and a color coded music system. CIMN has a good staff and all announcers are students here at UPEI. All DJ's follow the stations color coded music system from 3am until 7pm. After 7pm there is an open format. The DJ's are free to

program their own shows. There are still a couple of openings for announcers if any students are interested he or she could drop up to the station and fill out an application. As well as broadcasting on the air, our station has closed circuit facilities into the Panther Lounge, Robertson Library Lounge, and the cafeteria. New sound systems have been installed in the Panther Lounge and the Library Lounge.

Joe Ghiz; I would suggest that P.E.I. would simply plug into the Canadian system. We would be entitled to, as a constitutional right, the same power rates that exist in the rest of the country. I don't see how we can survive if you're suggesting that we should go on and forget about the federal government...I just don't accept that.

The Sun; Finally, are there any points in your campaign that you would like to clarify for U.P.E.I. students? Perhaps with respect to student aid? Joe Ghiz;...I don't have any new opinions. I remain committed to the ideal that all young people in this country have a basic right to education- the same as Islanders have a right to power rates. People have a

basic right to education and I see it as the function of the Island government to effectively negotiate with Ottawa and our sister provinces to get the best possible deal in education that is achievable. And that means that the people who can't afford to go to university for one reason or another are assisted by the province and by the federal government whether through a bursary program or any other form of student aid. Sun Prognosis; Mr. Ghiz may in fact be able to supply all of the items proposed in his platform for the stated sum of \$8 million.
