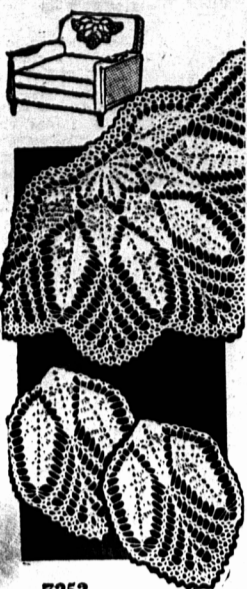

That Body Of Yours

is a breakdown of a tumor that the first symptoms usually appear. Because of this fact lung cancer may be treated as pneumonia in the early stages, particularly pneumonia known as virus pneumonia.

In investigating the cause or causes of lung cancer, X-ray is considered the most valuable method because of the ease with which it is done and because it is in the upper lobe of the lung that cancer is most frequently found. A tumor or growth which is not large enough to obstruct the bronchus completely permitting air to get beyond the tumor as a result of dilation of the bronchial tube, yet not permitting air to get out during expiration because of contraction of the bronchus, will cause localized obstruction — emphysema (small air sacs kept dilated by air in the lungs). This condition indicates a growth (cancer). Positive diagnosis of cancer of the lung can be made only by demonstrating cancer cells in the material obtained from the bronchus. "At the time of exploring for cancer, a biopsy (cutting out) a small

COPING WITH FREAKISH DISTRIBUTION

Freakish distribution of the opposing hands gave South some trouble in the following deal, but he came up with the winning line of play.

South dealer.

There was little point in North's asking for kings after South showed one ace — it was not to be considered that South, having passed originally, could hold an ace, two kings and good enough spades to make a grand-slam contract conceivable. So North simply bid the small slam directly.

Despite North's original two-heart bid, West elected to lead the heart jack as the safest opening he could find. Dummy won, and declarer cashed the ace and king of trumps. It was unpleasant news that a trump trick would have to be lost. South now tested the hearts, and when East showed out in that suit also, South had to put on his thinking cap.

Obviously, only one discard would be available on the heart suit, so other measures were urgently needed. South cashed dummy's third heart trick, discarding a club, then ruffed a heart. Now he took the unavoidable diamond finesse, and he felt better when the queen held. He cashed the diamond ace, ruffed dummy's last heart — incidentally removing West's last card in that suit — and then ruffed his own last diamond.
