**L**ast Thursday, nine brave souls dared to stand up in front of their peers and let the world know just how funny they really are- or are they?

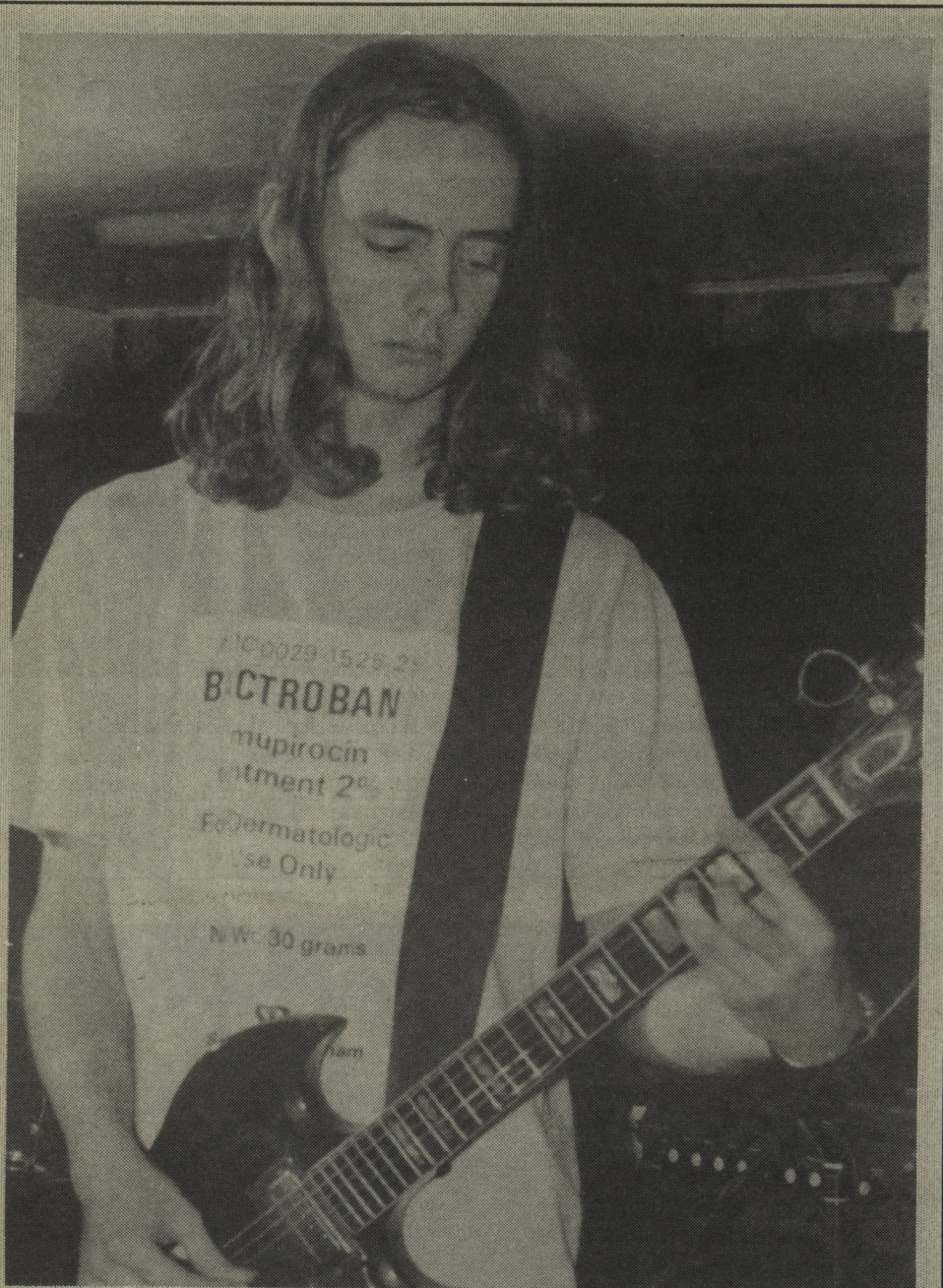
