 2. Salary \$800.00 (\$400.00 at the end of each term)
 3. Terms of Appointment
- Dons are appointed for the academic year, Sept. 1 to May 1 approximately. During this period they have the use of a private room in the residence and receive a stipend. A job description is available along with the application form at the Manpower Office.
