The outside of the building should blend well with the rest of UPEI as it is brick with only steel on the upperpart.

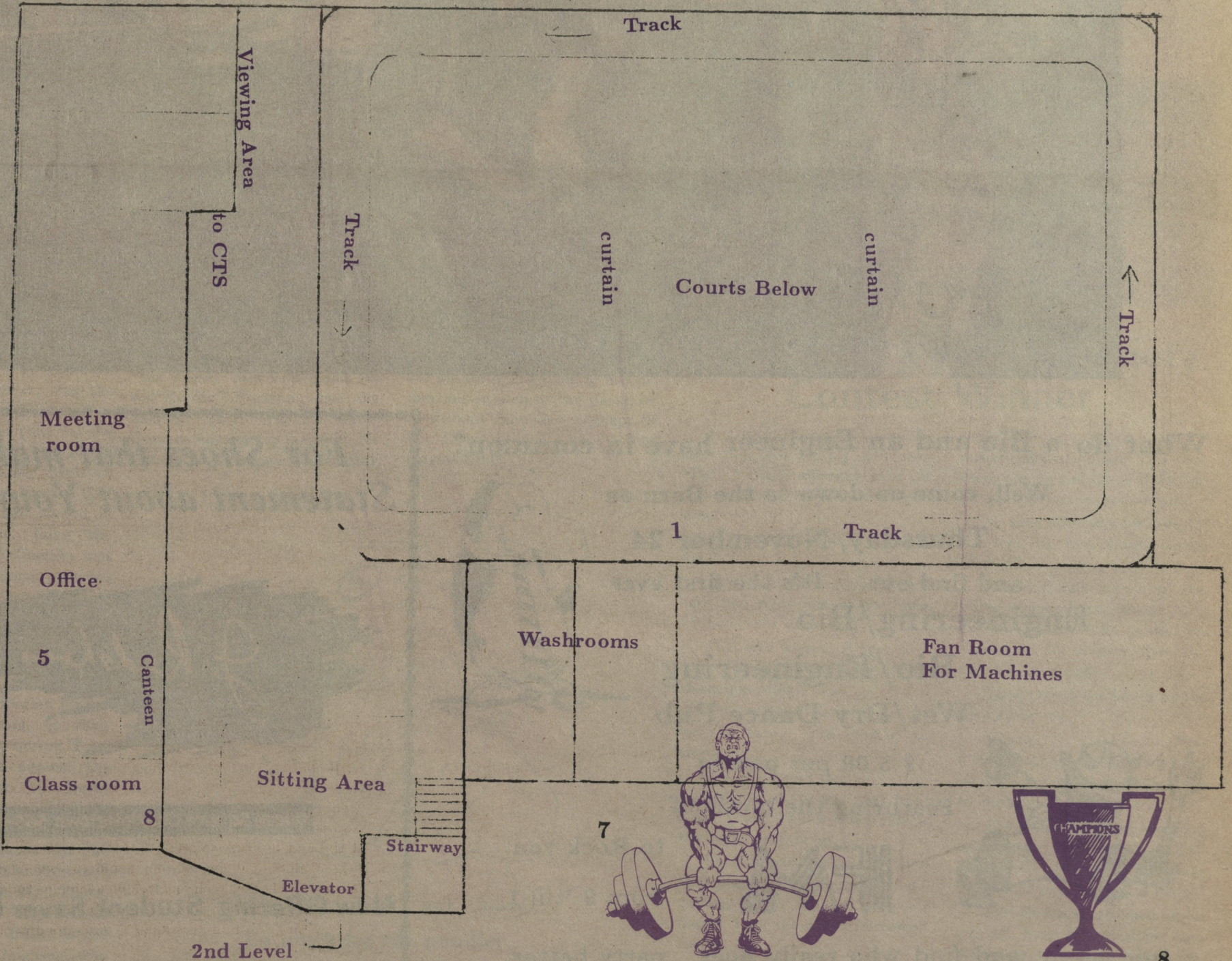
In the design there are plans for a fixed link to a renovated arena. It will join up at the lower entry. There were plans to locate a near arena across
