Opening lead—two of hearts.  
How the defenders' cards are distributed frequently has a critical effect on the result of the play of a hand. The outcome of declarer's play can be greatly affected by whether the adverse cards are so placed that attempted finesses succeed, or by whether suits break favorably.

But not all hands depend solely upon the distribution of the opponents' cards. There are also a great many hands in which declarer, by the exercise of appropriate skill, can overcome an adverse lie of the cards.

For example, in this deal, it would appear at first blush that

### Pickets Stop Newfoundland Pulp Shipments

GRAND FALLS, Nfld. (CP)—Striking loggers Monday stopped two independent contractors from crossing picket lines with pulp wood for the Anglo-Newfoundland Development Company plant here.

A spokesman for the International Woodworkers of America (IWA) said the union loggers stopped contractor Frank Burt from crossing a picket line at Badger. He was going to unload a shipment of wood in a river which flows past the mill.

Burt made no attempt to break through the line, the spokesman said.

Four trucks also tried to go through picket lines on the Leamington highway, about 12 miles west of nearby Botwood. The spokesman said picketers stopped the trucks and dumped the wood on the road, but later returned and cleared it away at the request of ROMP.
