**St. F. X. Students  
Pleased With  
Trip In Hearse**

MONTREAL (CP)—Five Mar-  
time college students will wheel  
out of town Friday aboard a  
wheezing, smoke-belching hearse  
which covered 900 miles in 32  
hours on the way up to Montreal  
from Nova Scotia.  
The five, all students at St.  
Francis Xavier University in  
Antigonish, N. S., bought the  
hearse, vintage 1940, at a used-  
car lot. They installed some  
chairs and drove it home to Mon-  
treal during Christmas vacation.  
The long, low vehicle has sat  
on the street in front of Paul Col-  
vey's home in west-end Notre  
Dame de Grace since it arrived.  
Colvey, Jack Hamilton and  
George Sanderson, of Montreal,  
Jack Doherty of Saint John, N.B.,  
and Dave Maynard of Edmonton  
bought the hearse and hope to  
re-sell it in Antigonish.  
In all, nine students started the  
trip. The other four were charged  
a fare.

**SLOW STARTER**  
The students appeared pleased  
with their purchase.  
"It sort of starts slowly on six  
of its eight cylinders. It hasn't  
got much pickup but it has lots  
of power," said one of the  
drivers.

The hearse was purchased as  
a matter of economics, although  
it is hard on gas. It averaged 13  
miles to the gallon on the high-  
way, less in towns.  
"It was in a used-car lot in  
Antigonish and we passed it  
every afternoon on our walks  
downtown," one of the group said.  
"We did have competition in  
the purchase. There was a 'syn-  
dicate' from North Adams,  
Mass., and another from Toronto  
that had their eyes on it but we  
were first to the lot with the  
cash."  
They declined to reveal the  
price to protect the re-sale value  
but it was understood to be less  
than \$300.

**Father Suicides,  
Mother Dies 8  
Hours Later**

MONTGOMERY, Ala. (AP)—A  
stricken mother of 12 children  
died here eight hours after her  
husband jumped to his death  
from a downtown building in ap-  
parent dependency over her ill-  
ness.  
Mrs. Willie Evelyn Sheffield, 52  
died from a cerebral hemorrhage  
shortly before midnight without  
learning that her husband, Gleas-  
on Sheffield, 50, had taken his  
life.  
Coroner M. B. Kirkpatrick said  
Sheffield was despondent over his  
wife's health. The family had  
been told she wasn't expected to  
live.  
Kirkpatrick said a 16-year-old  
son, Chester, saw his father  
plunge from a second-floor win-  
dow and land on his head on a  
concrete sidewalk 20 feet below.  
The Sheffield had 11 other  
children.

**2,000 Damage  
Actions Loom**

MONTREAL (CP)—The City of  
Montreal faces more than 2,000  
damage actions totalling at least  
\$1,000,000 as a result of a three-  
inch rainfall last June 25 which  
flooded basements and underpas-  
ses.  
City hall sources said the city  
will argue that flood damages  
were "acts of God" and not due  
to failure to provide adequate  
drainage facilities.  
Actions have been deposited in  
Superior Court and magistrate's  
court. A number of suburban mu-  
nicipalities are also faced with ac-  
tions.  
All allege that Island municipa-  
lities failed to develop drainage  
and sewage systems capable of  
providing for recent expansion in  
housing facilities.

**Governor of  
Chinese Prov.  
Is Expelled**

PEIPING (Reuters) — The gov-  
ernor and three other senior men  
of the key Chinese province of  
Chekiang have been expelled  
from the Communist party as  
"rightists," the Peiping People's  
Daily reported Friday.  
The newspaper, mouthpiece of  
the party, said Governor Sha Wen  
Han, Vice-Governor Yang Su I,  
Provincial Public Prosecutor  
Peng Lui Lin and Trade Depart-  
ment Chief Sun Chang Lu were  
"bourgeois individualist extrem-  
ists—the root of all evil."  
A plenary conference of the  
Chekiang Communist party in  
Hangchow earlier this month de-  
nounced the "guilty activities of  
these four leading rightists."  
**DROPPED INTO WHIRLPOOL**  
The Peiping People's Daily said  
all four had "strong individualis-  
tic ambitions, keeping always in  
mind their reputations, self-inter-  
ests and personal positions. They  
dropped into a whirlpool of right-  
ist thought."  
The denunciations "received  
admiration and support with one  
accord" at the party conference,  
the paper said. The conference  
voted unanimously to expel all  
four from the party and recom-  
mended their dismissal from ad-  
ministrative posts.  
Sha was appointed governor in  
1955 after serving as president of  
Chekiang University and as a de-  
puty from the People's Libera-  
tion Army in East China to the  
Chinese People's consultative  
conference.
